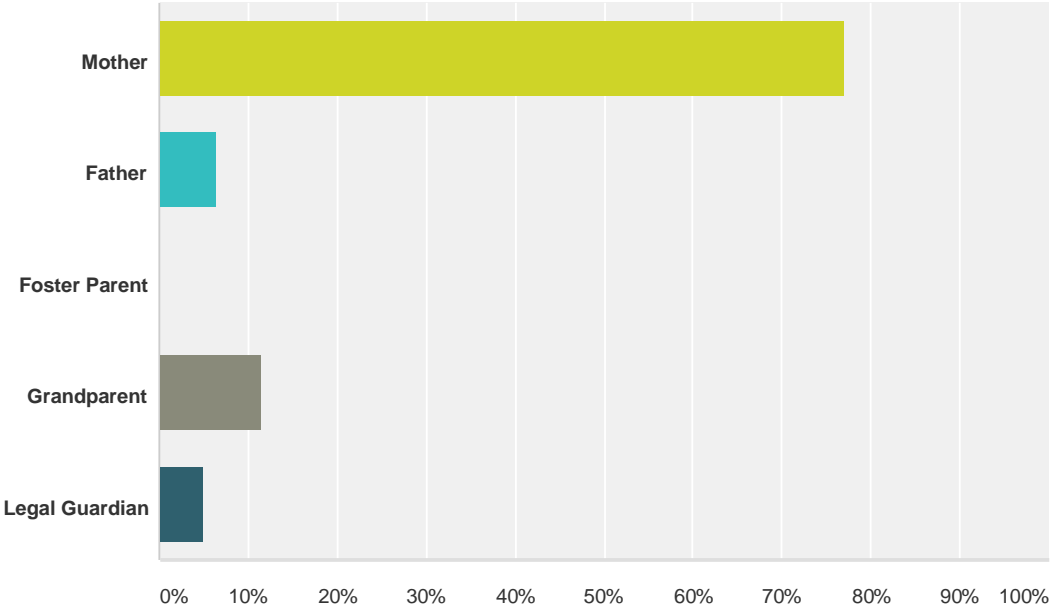

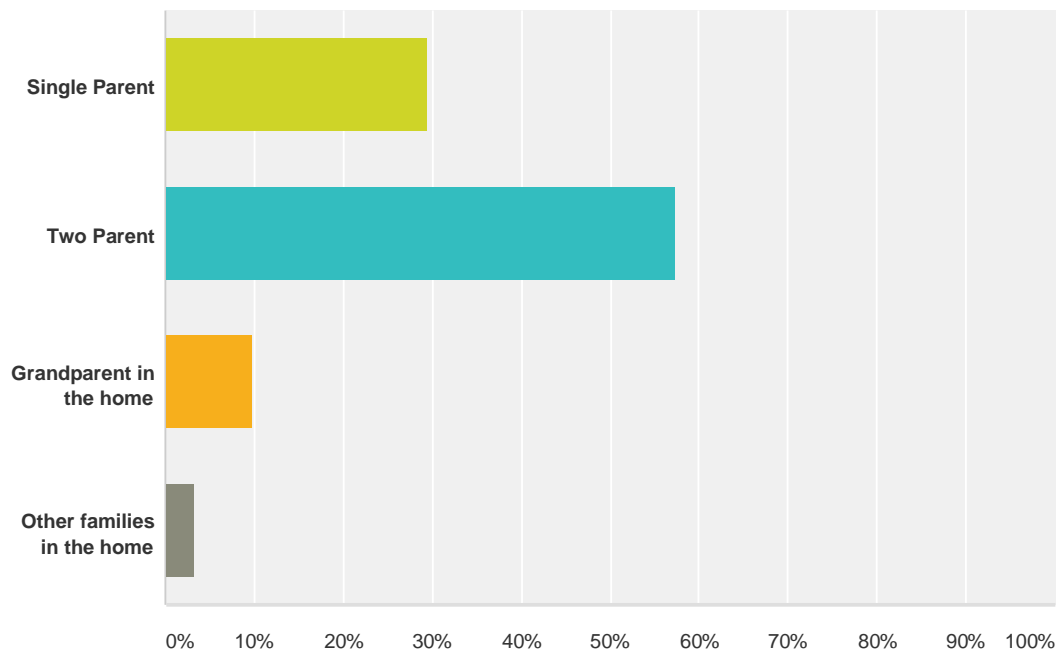

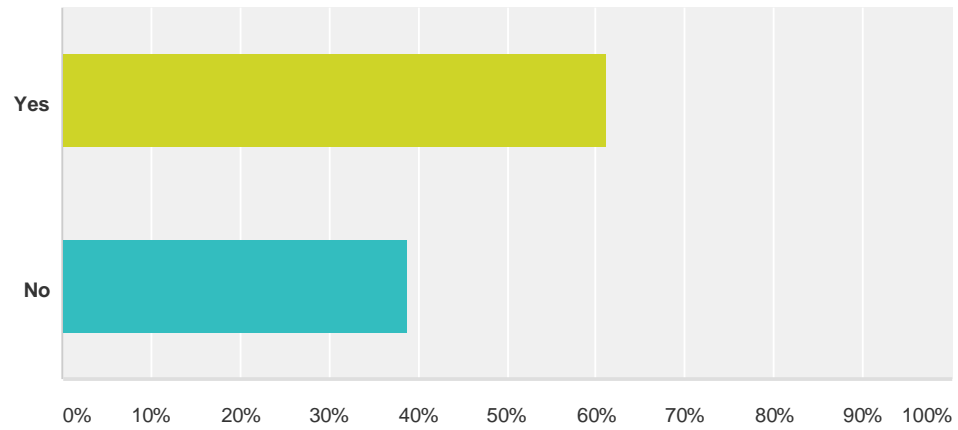

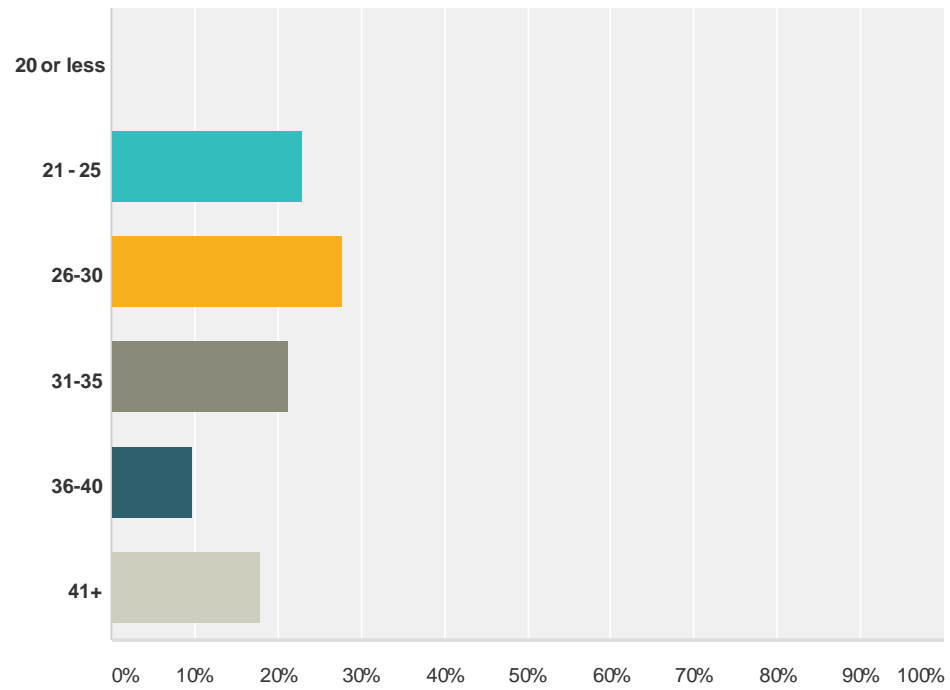

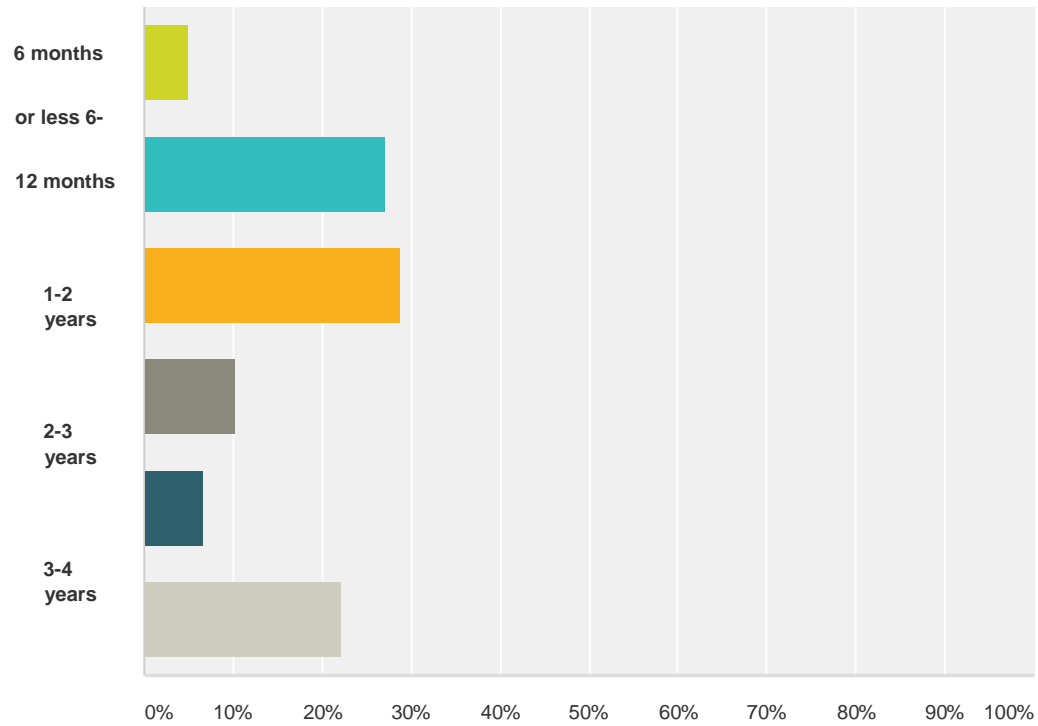

Q5 How long has your family had children (not just this child) enrolled in this program?

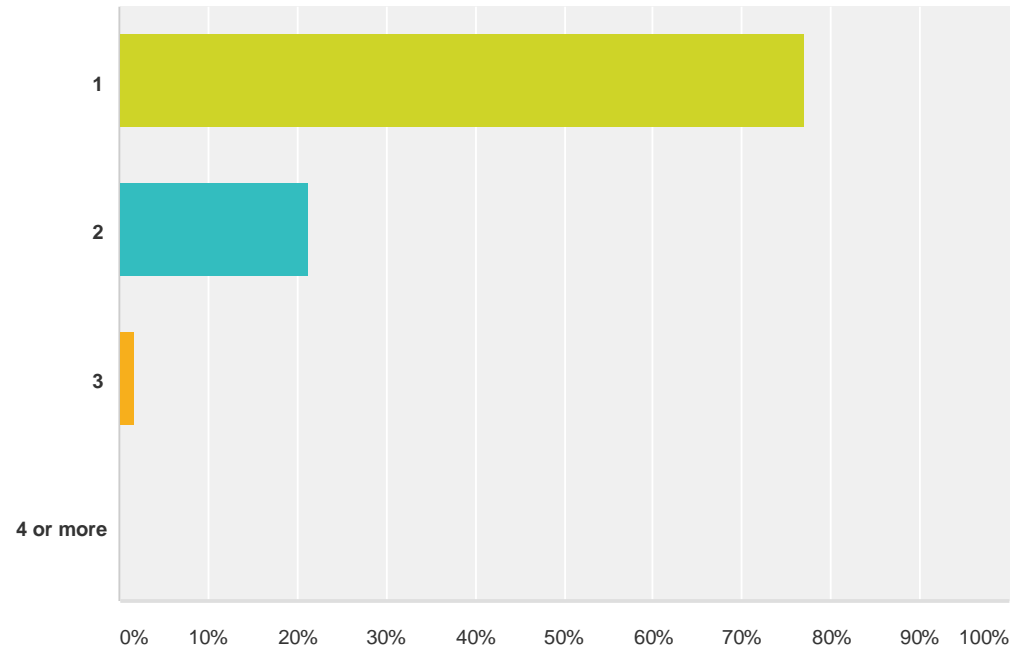

Q6 How many places have you lived in the past year?

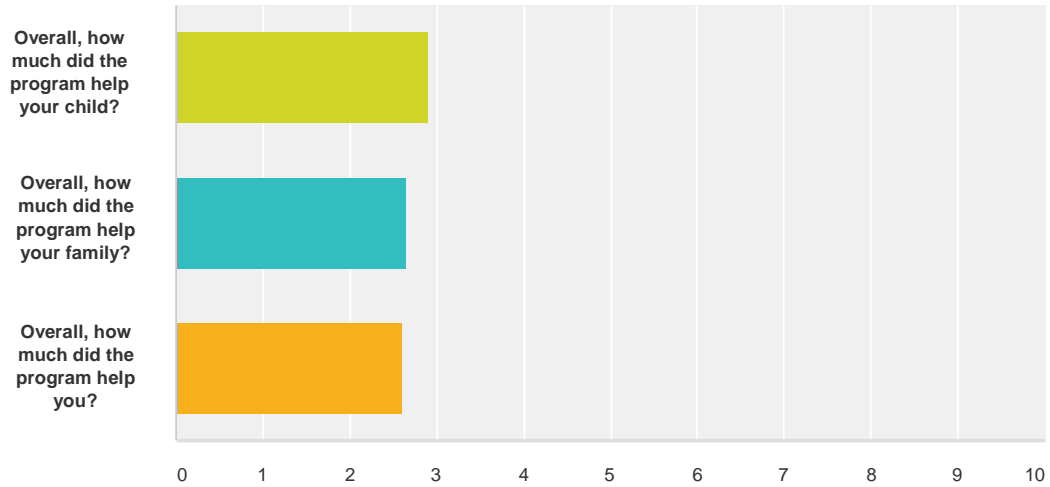

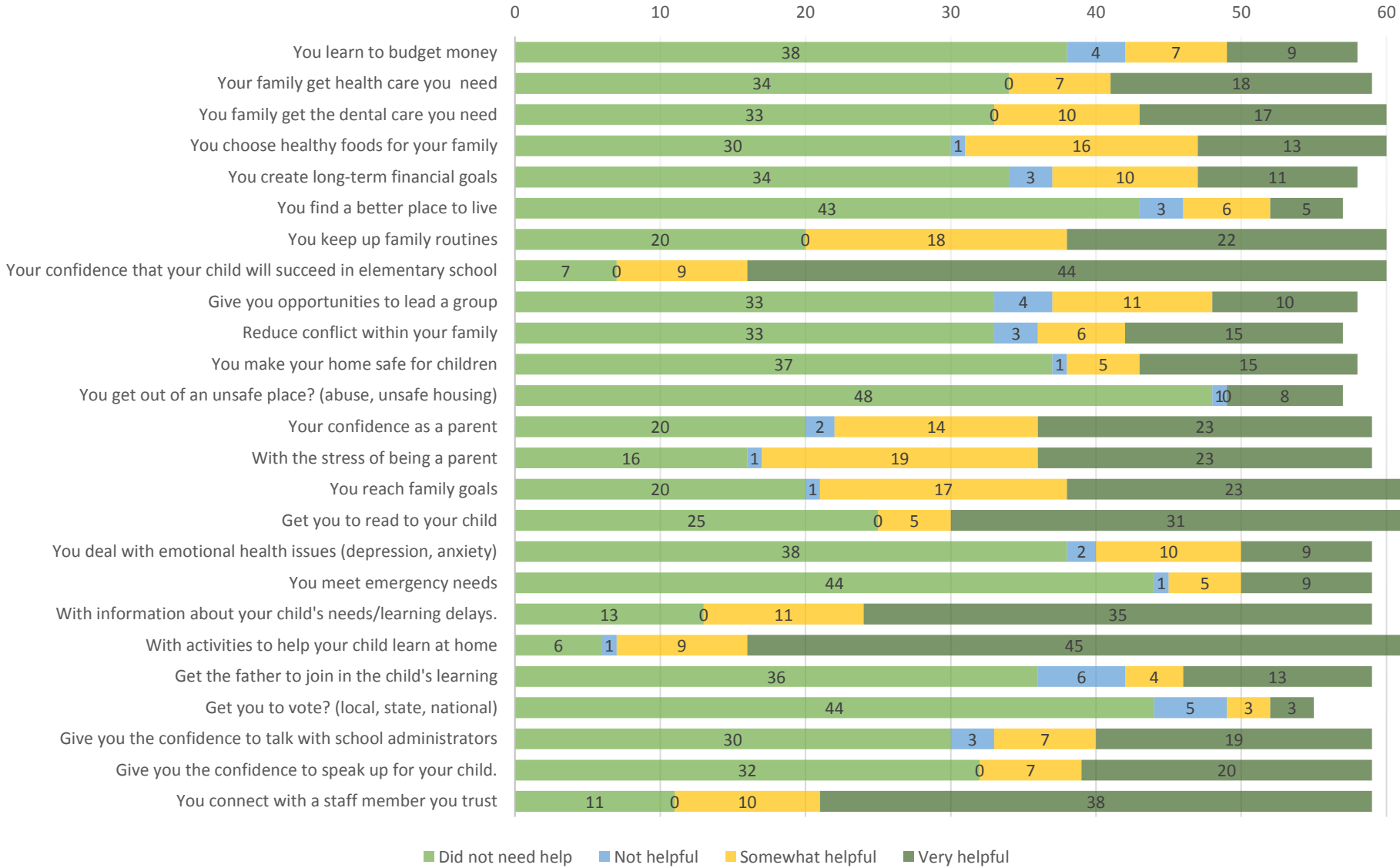

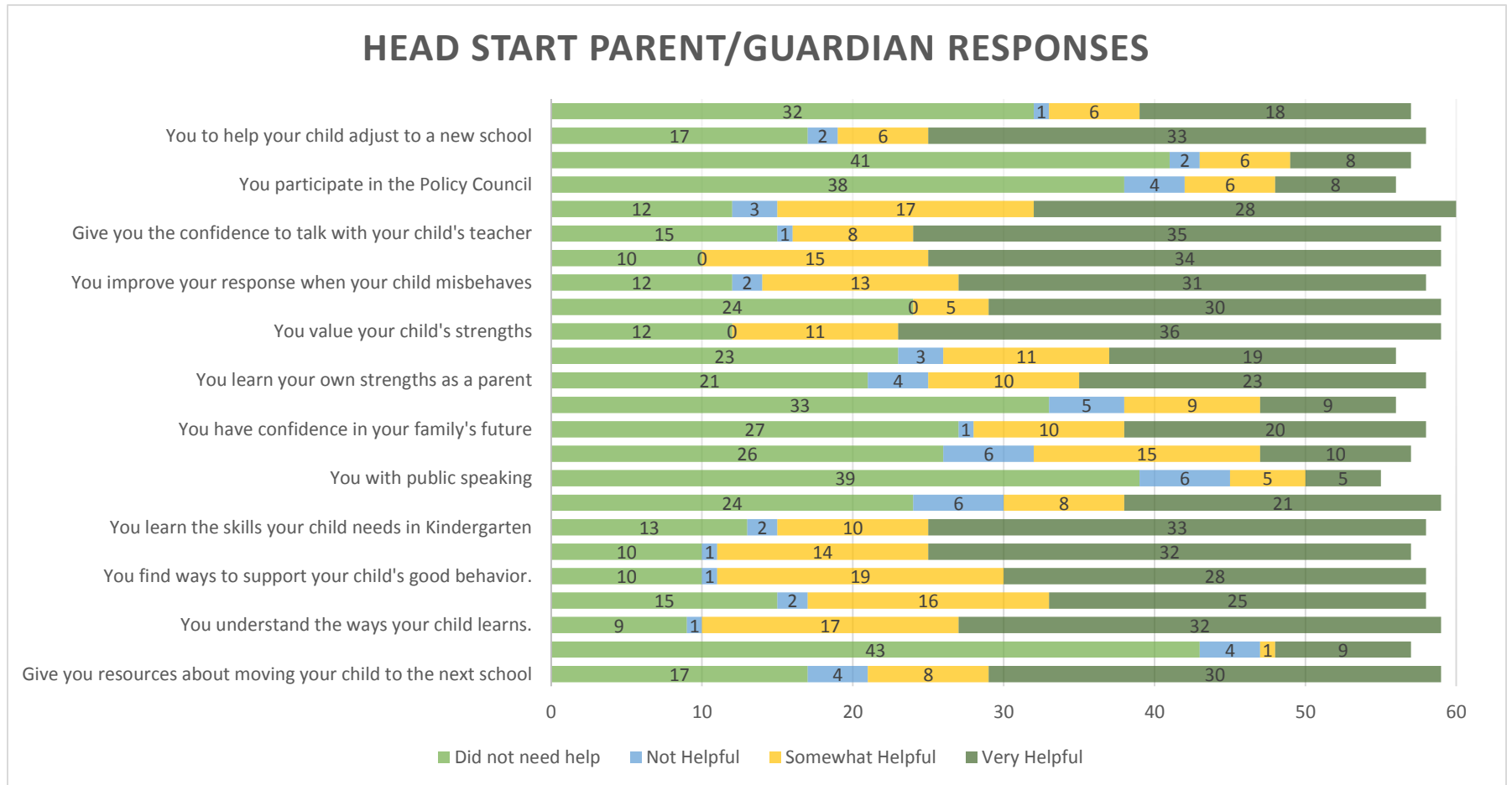
