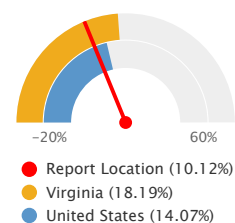

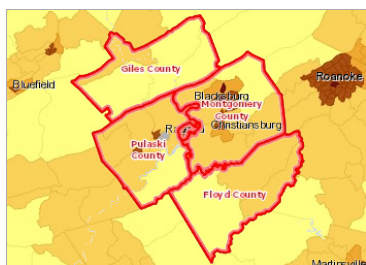

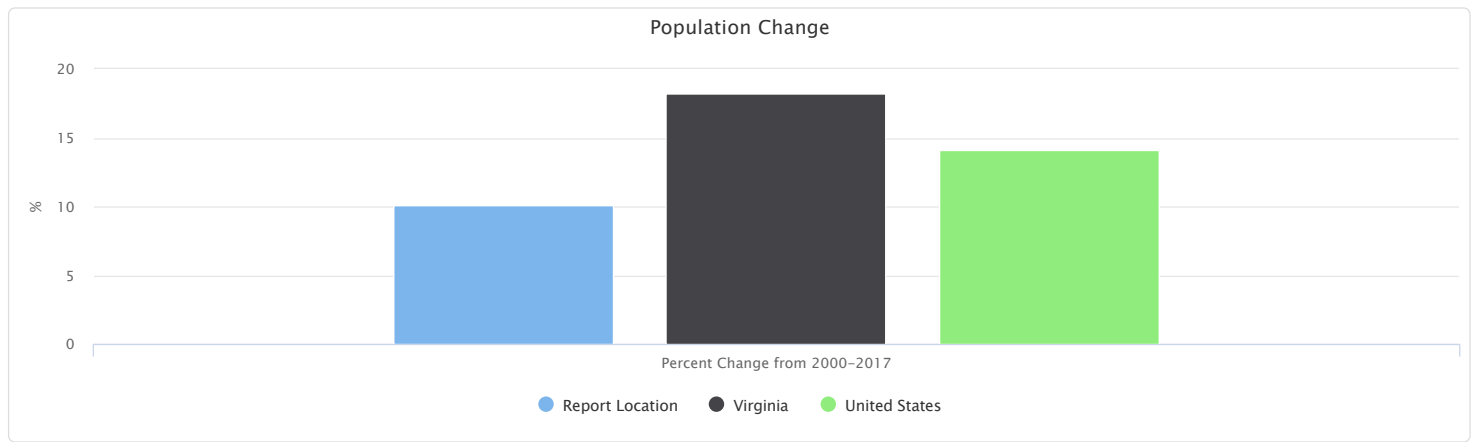

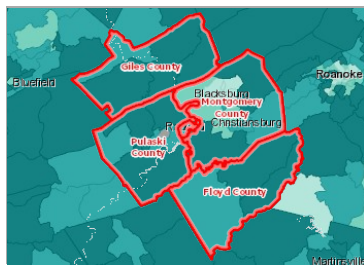

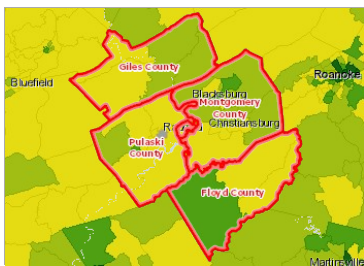


Race Demographics

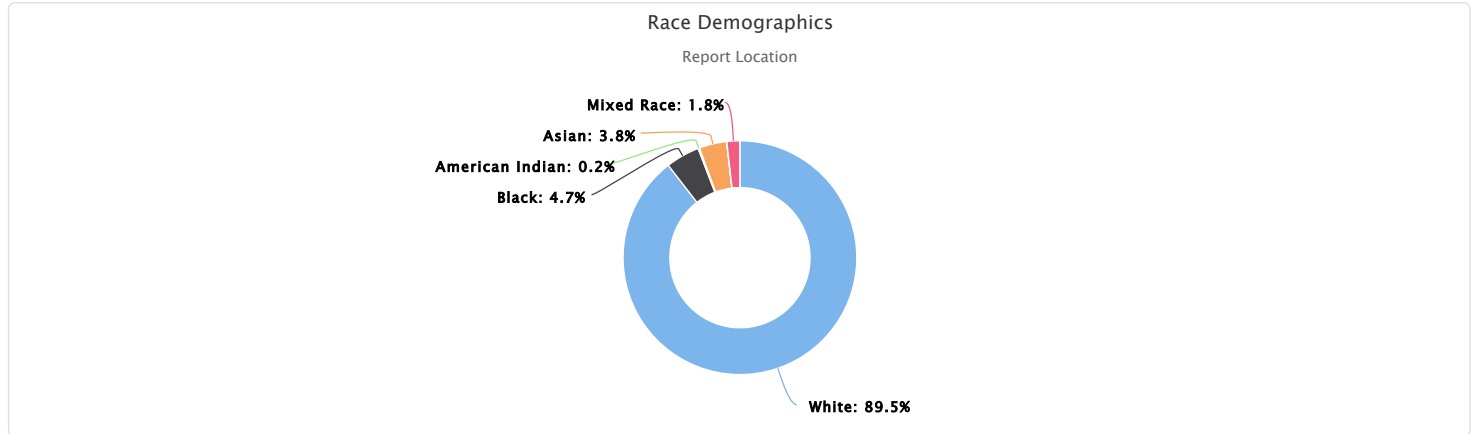
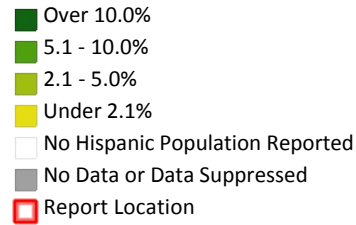

Population, Minority (Non-White), Percent by Tract, ACS 2013-17

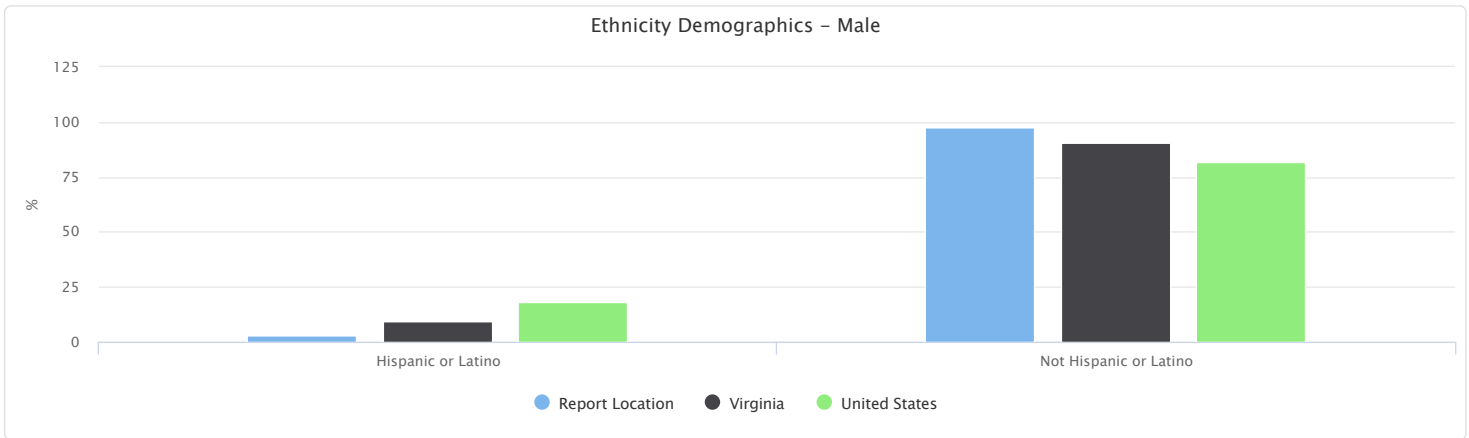

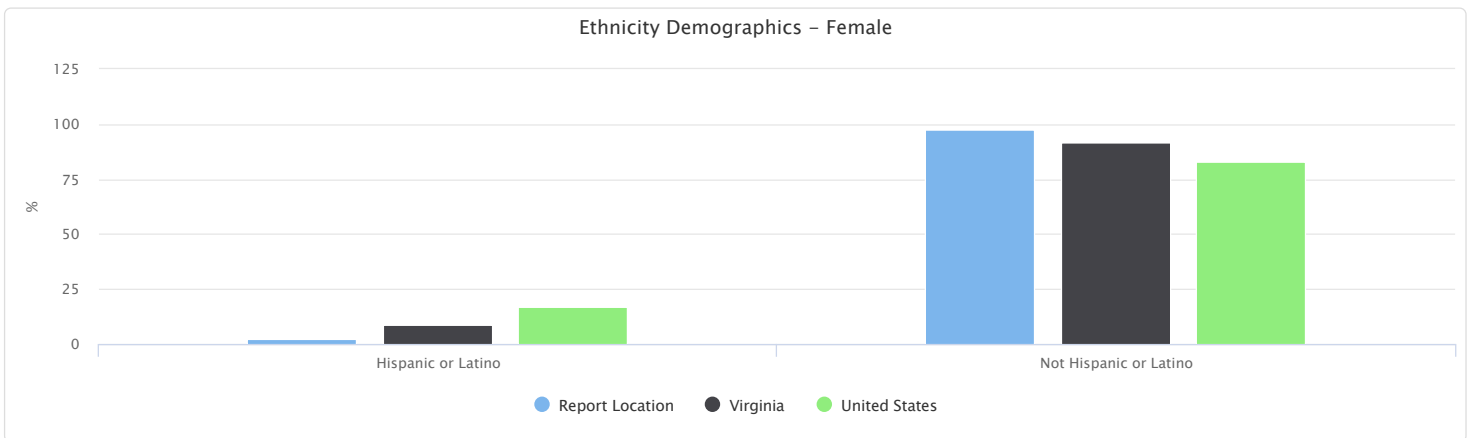

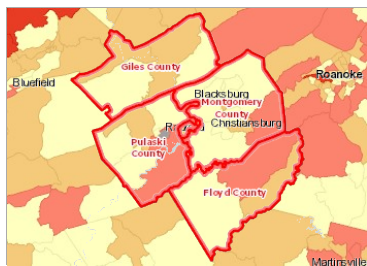


Veterans, Age and Gender Demographics

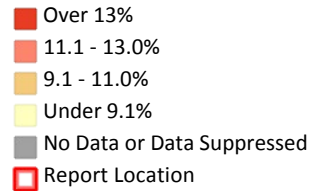

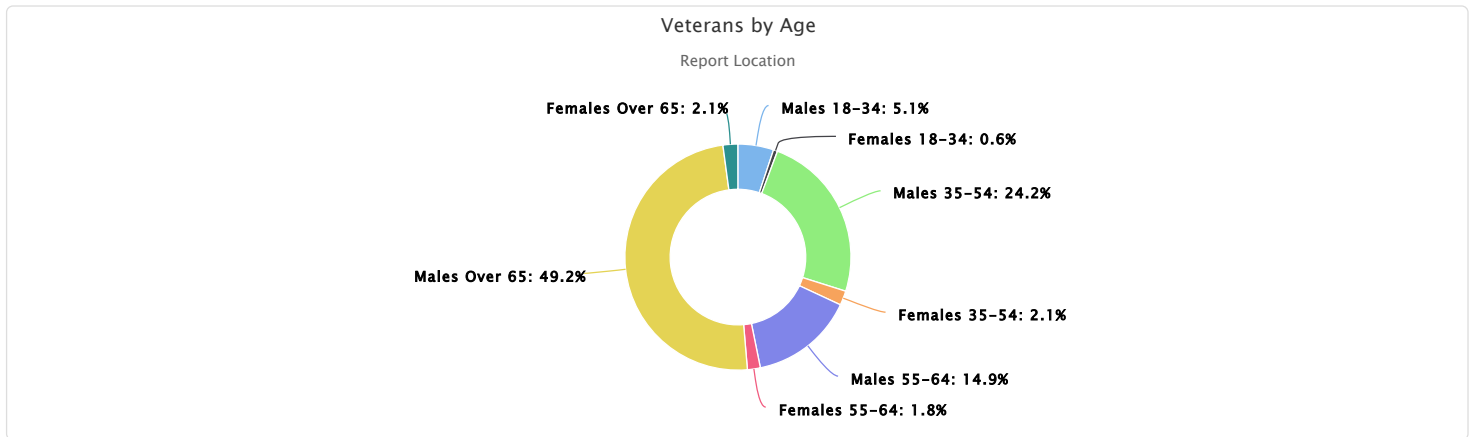
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Veterans, Percent of Total Population by Tract, ACS 2013-17

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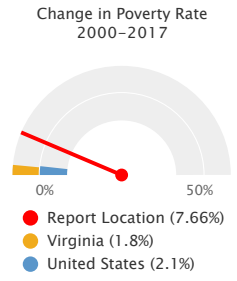
Population Below the Poverty Level, Percent by County, SAIPE 2017



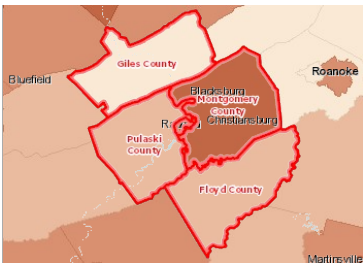
Poverty Rate Change

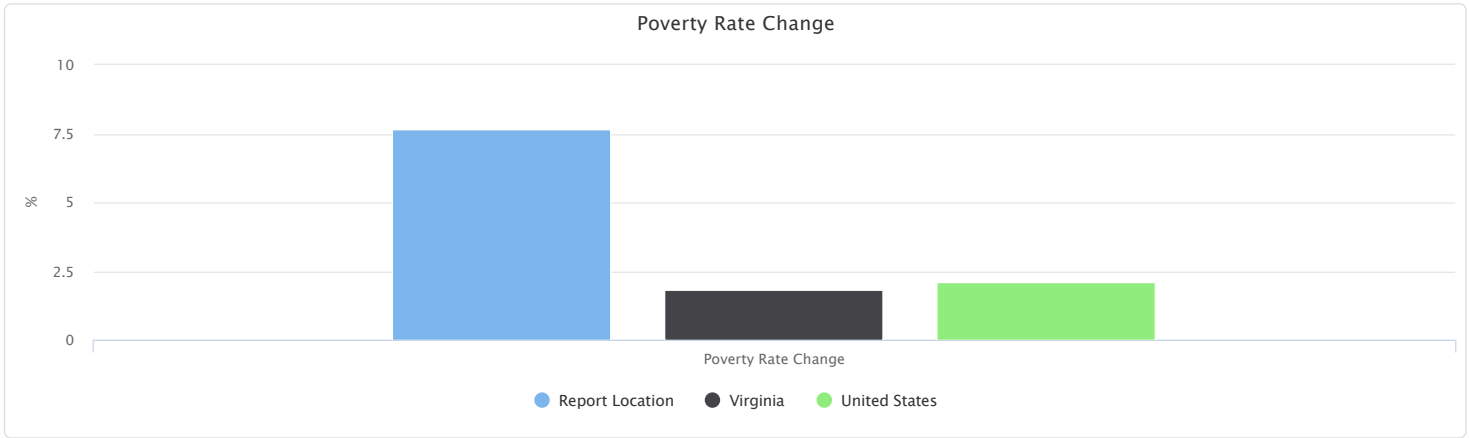
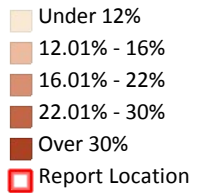

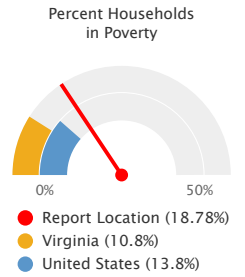
Population Below the Poverty Level, Percent by County, SAIPe 2017



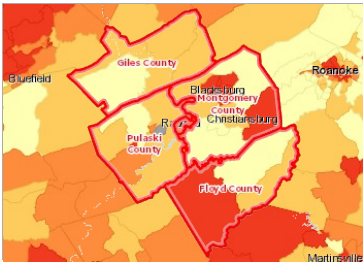

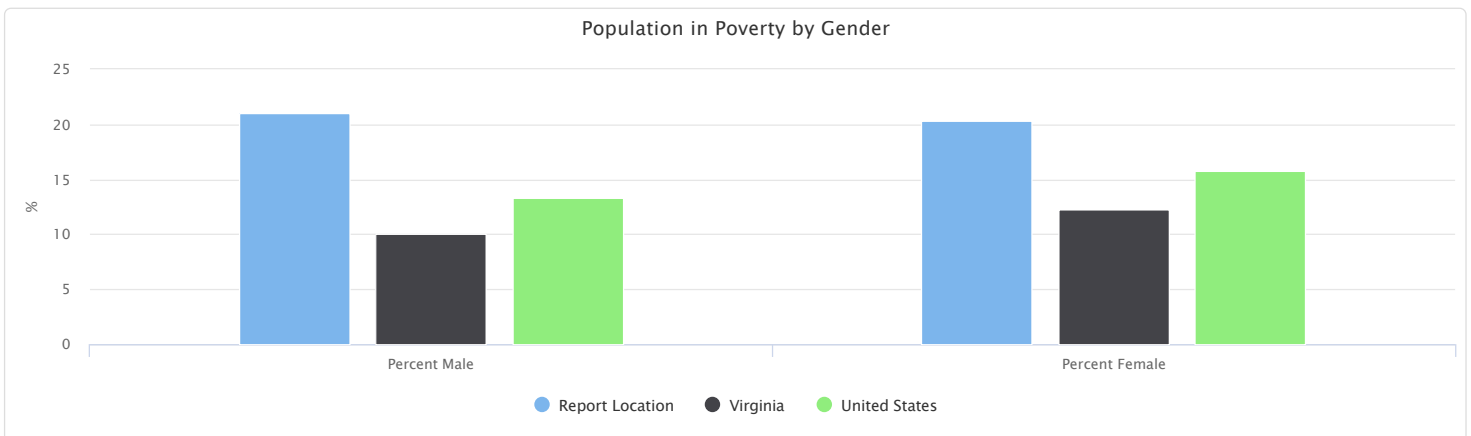
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Population Below the Poverty Level, Percent by Tract, ACS 2013-17



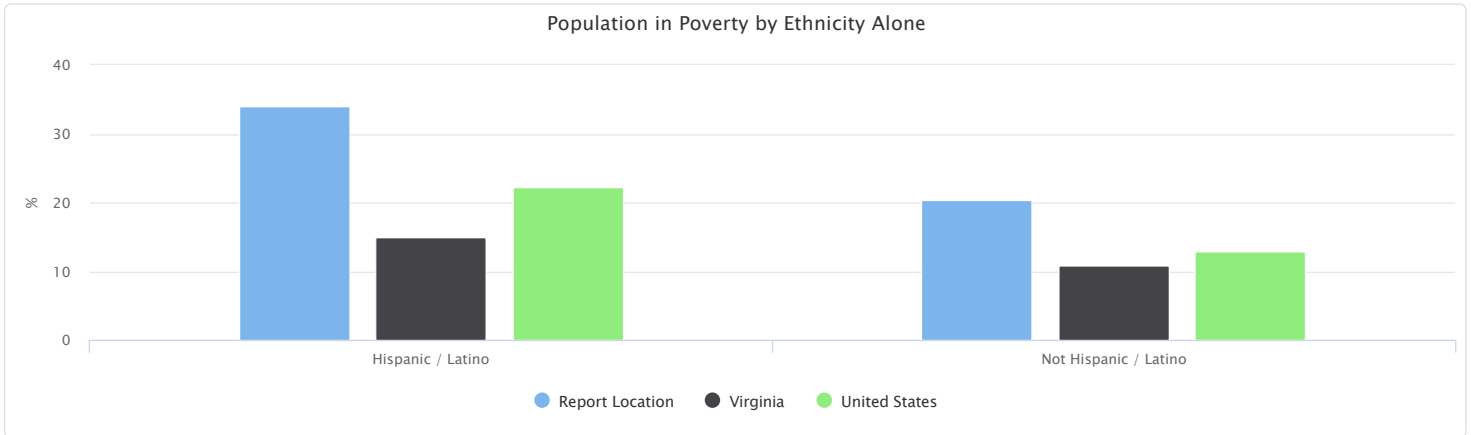

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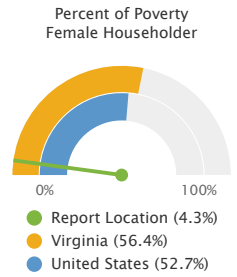
Married Family Households Living Below the Poverty Level, Percent by Tract, ACS 2013-17



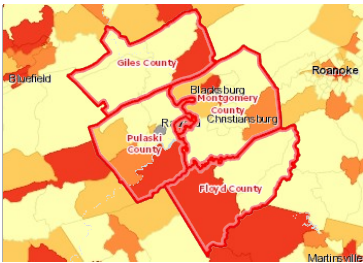

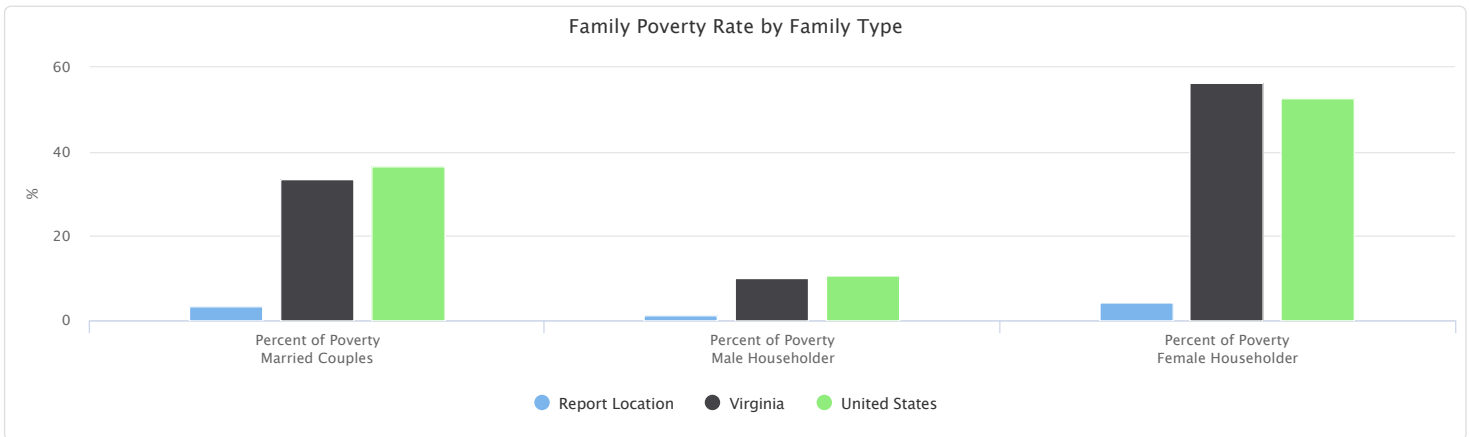

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Single Parent Family Households Living Below the Poverty Level, Percent by Tract, ACS 2013-17

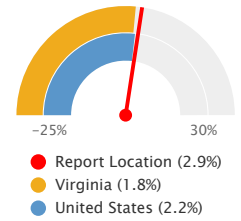

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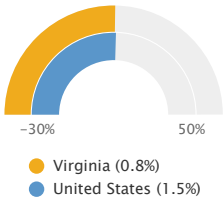
Population Below the Poverty Level, Children (Age 0-18), Percent by County, SAIGE 2017



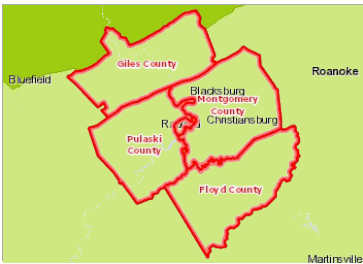

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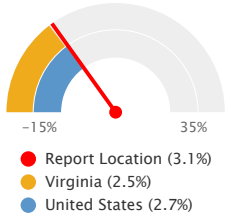
Population Below the Poverty Level, Children (Age 0-4), Percent by State, SAIPE 2017



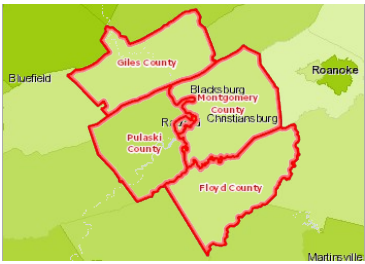

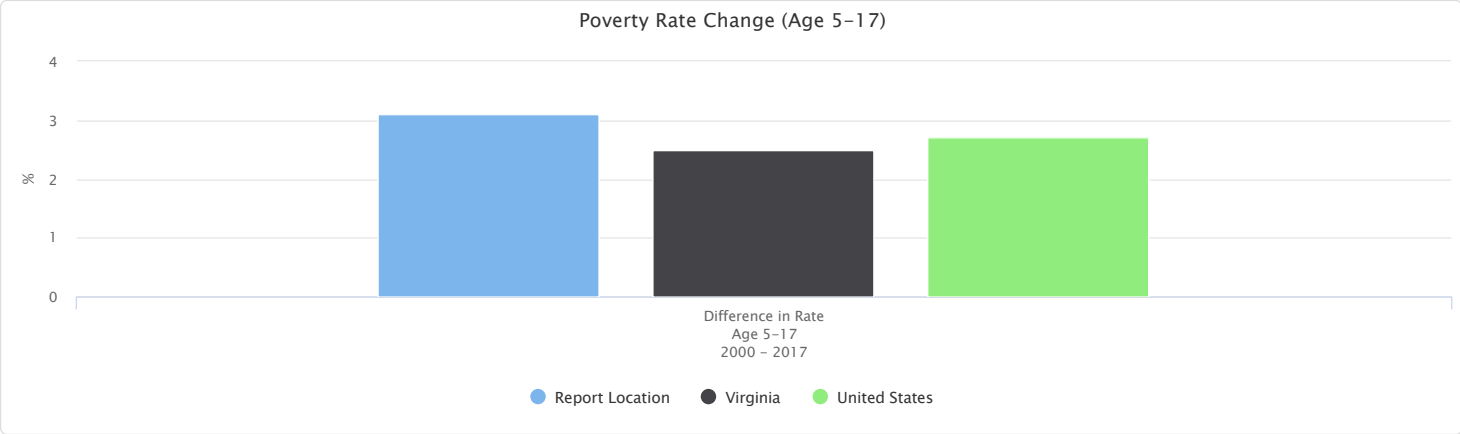
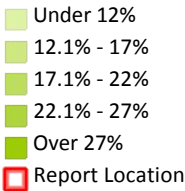

Population Below the Poverty Level, Children (Age 5-17), Percent by County, SAIGE 2017

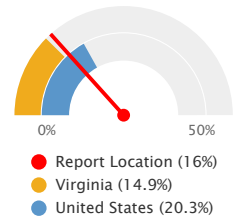

Ages 0-4 Poverty Rate



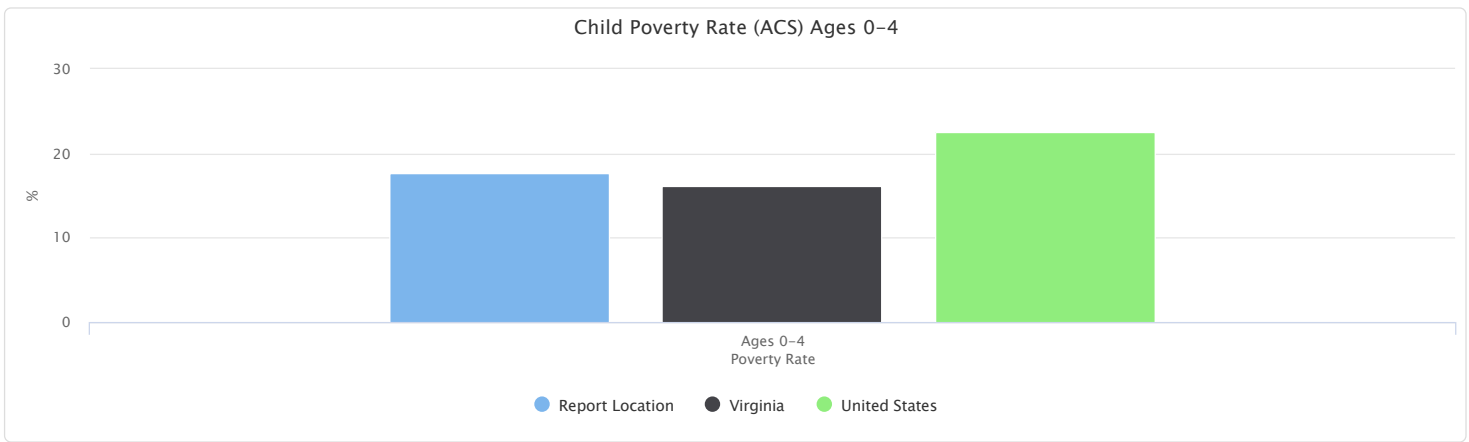

Ages 5-17 Poverty Rate



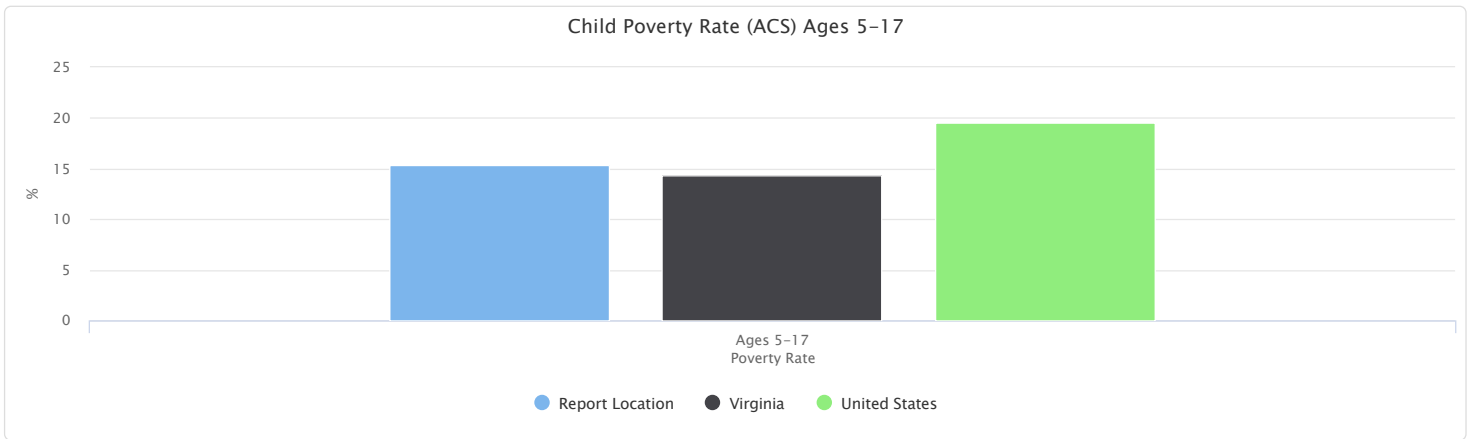

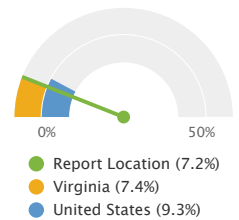

Unemployment, Rate by County, BLS 2019 - October



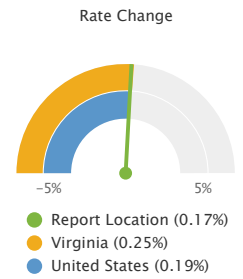
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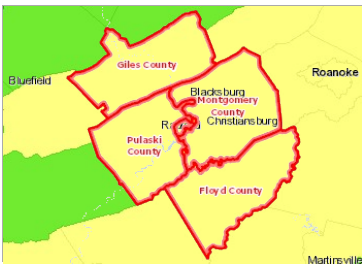

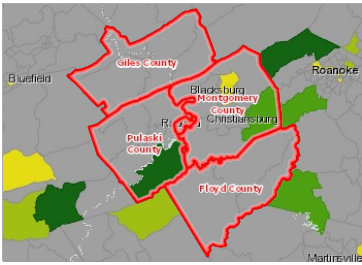

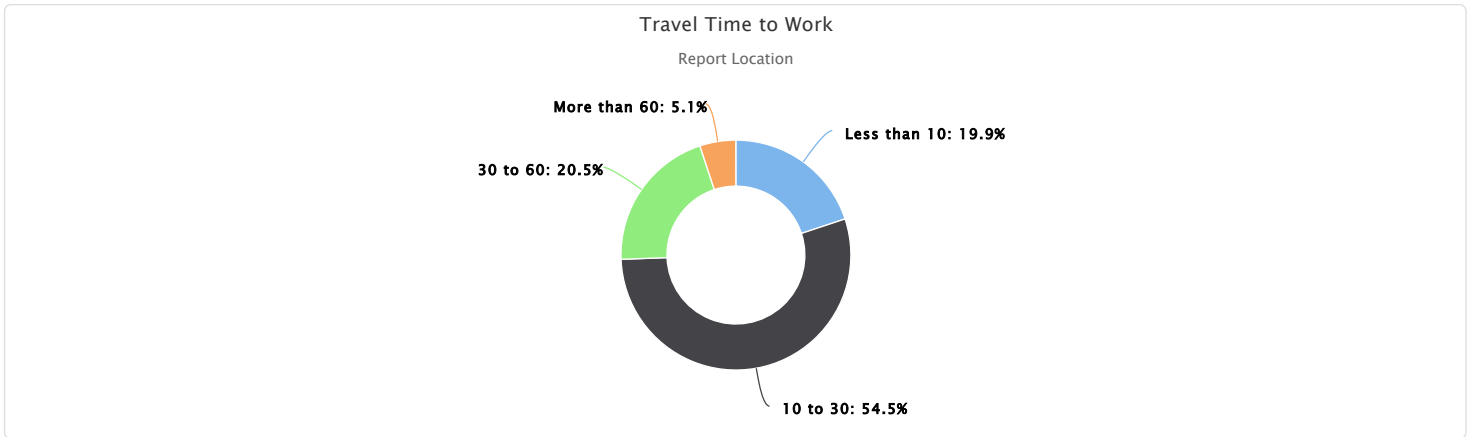

Average Work Commute Time (Minutes), Average by Tract, ACS 2013-17

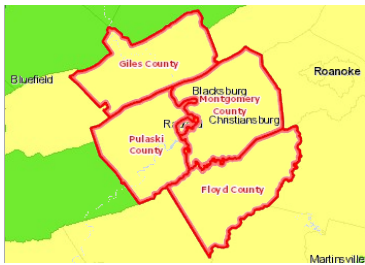

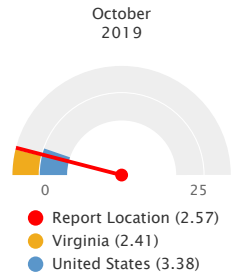
Unemployment, Rate by County, BLS 2019 - October



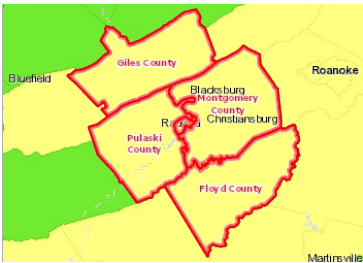

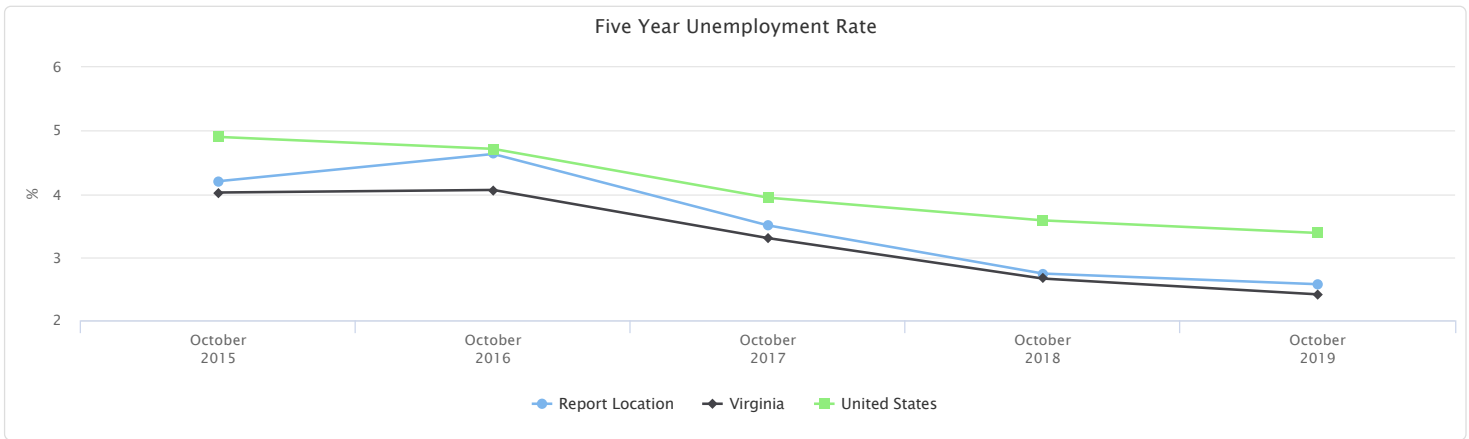
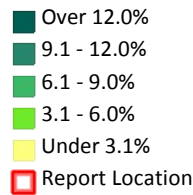

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Unemployment, Rate by County, BLS 2019 - October



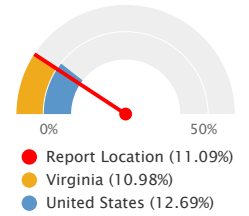

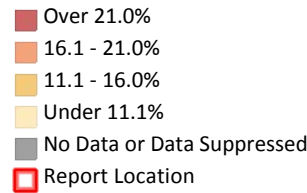

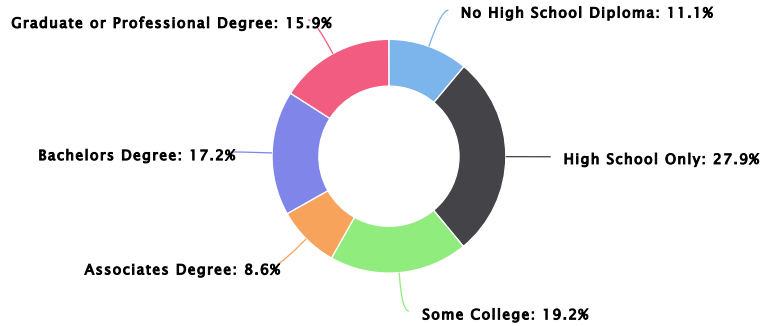
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Population with No High School Diploma (Age 18+), Percent by Tract, ACS 2013-17

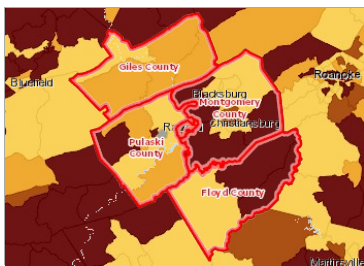

No High School Diploma, Veterans, Percent by Tract, ACS 2013-17



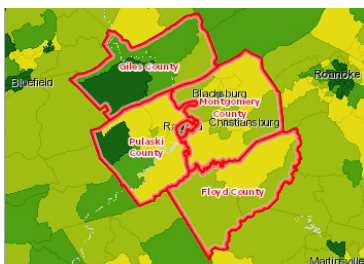

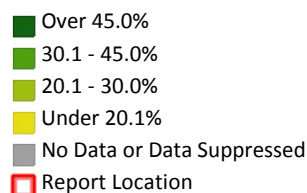

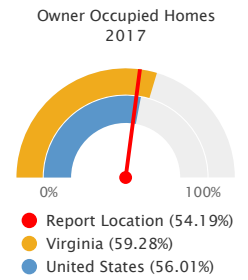
Housing Constructed Before 1960, Percent by Tract, ACS 2013-17



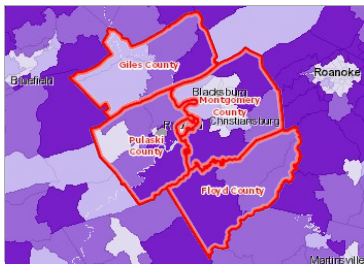

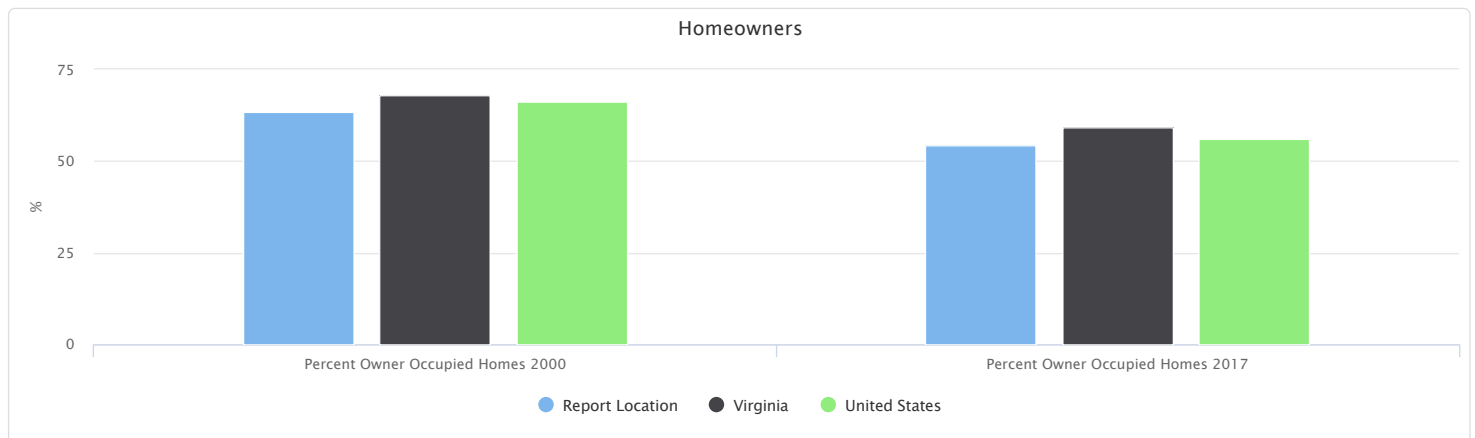
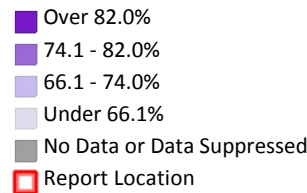

Owner-Occupied Housing Units, Percent by Tract, ACS 2013-17



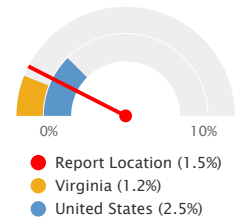

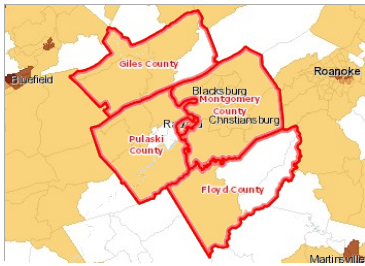

Residential Vacancy Rate



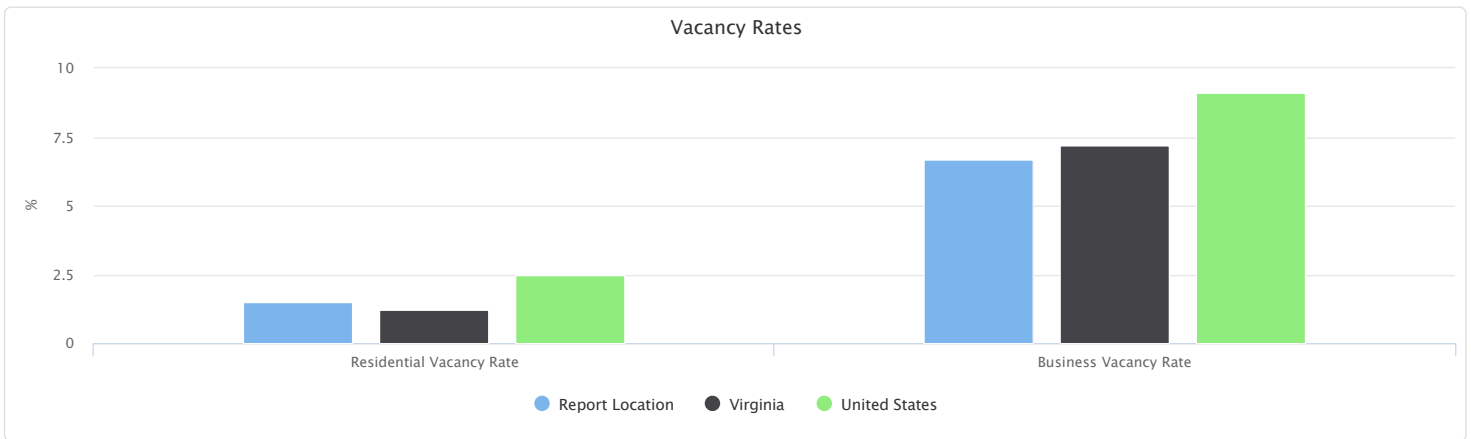

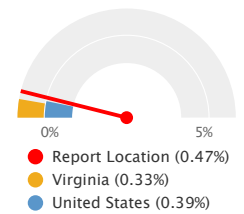

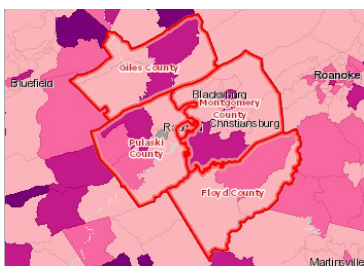

Percentage of Housing Units Without Complete Plumbing Facilities



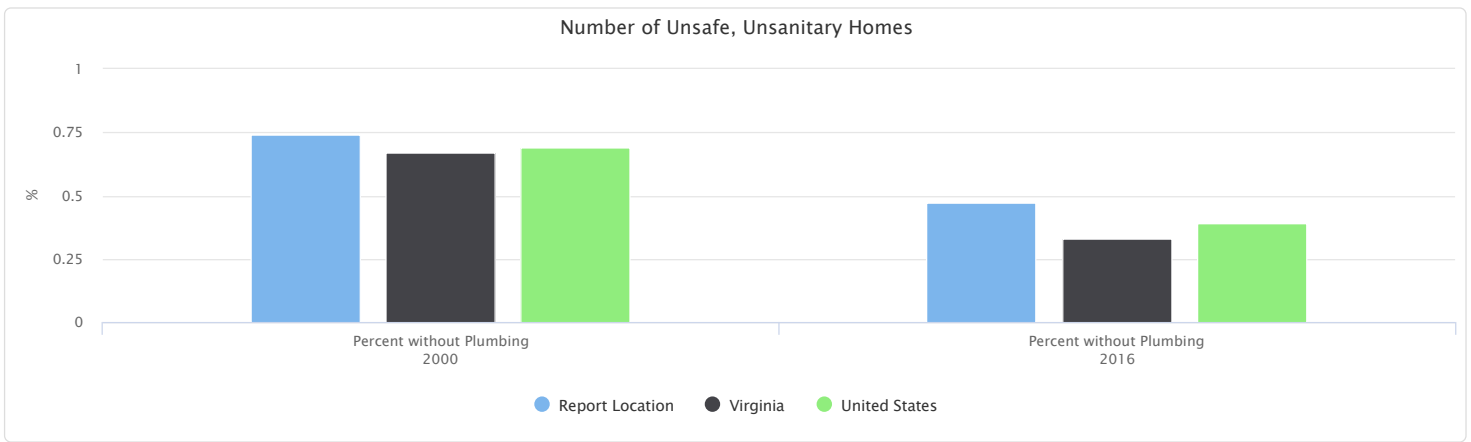

Housing Units Lacking Complete Plumbing Facilities, Percent by Tract, ACS 2013-17

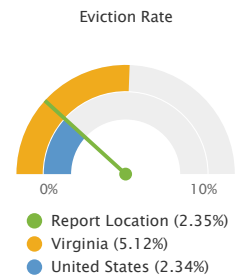

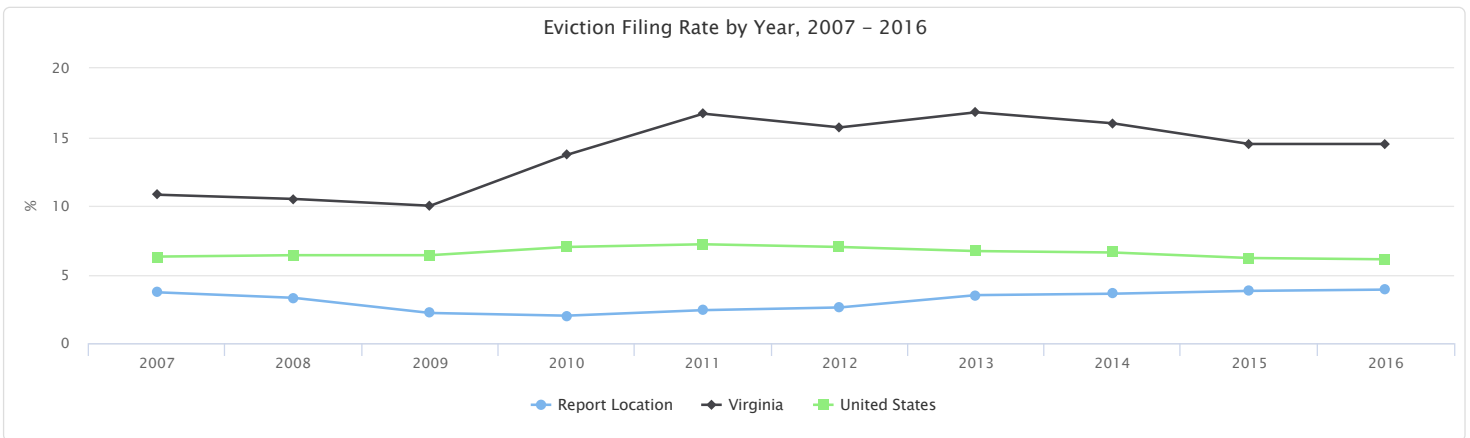

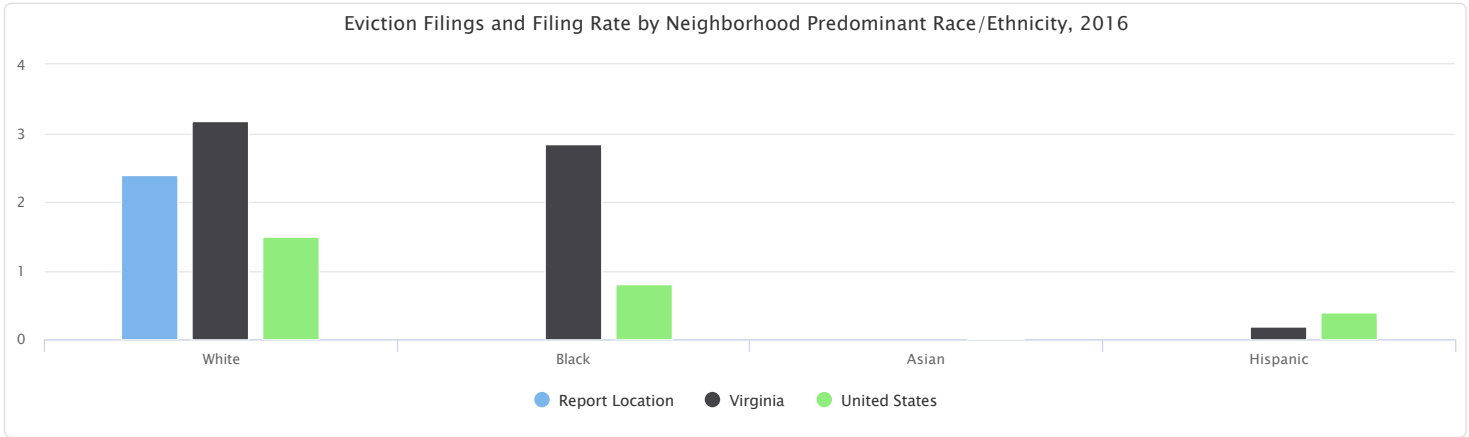

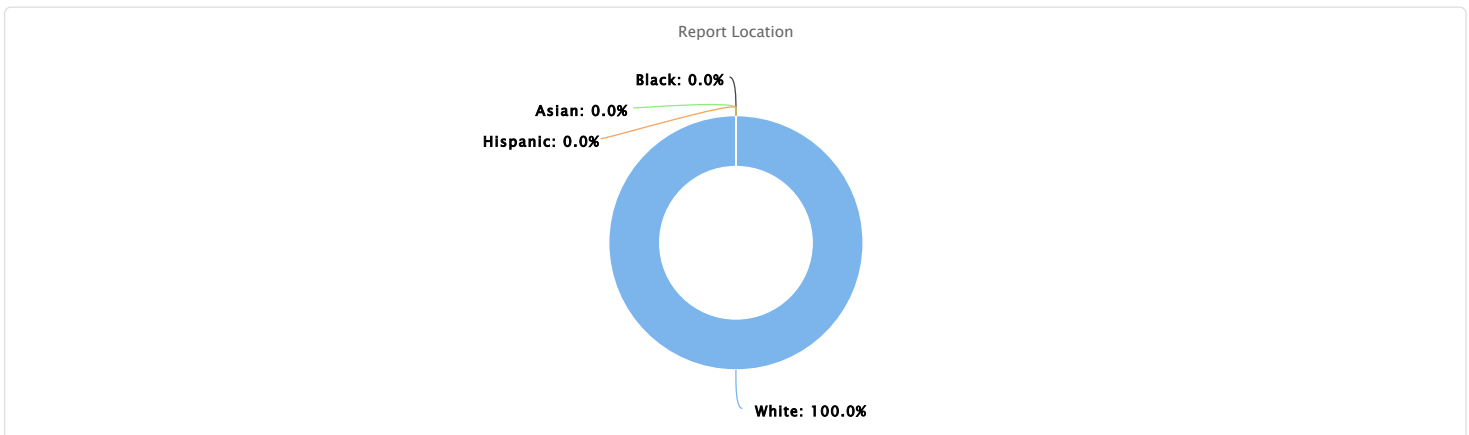

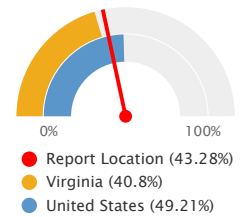

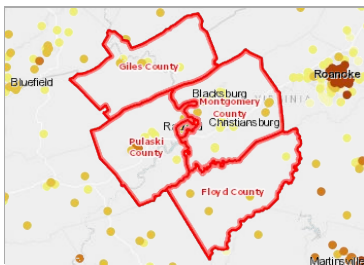

Students Eligible for Free or Reduced-Price Lunch, NCES CCD 2016-17

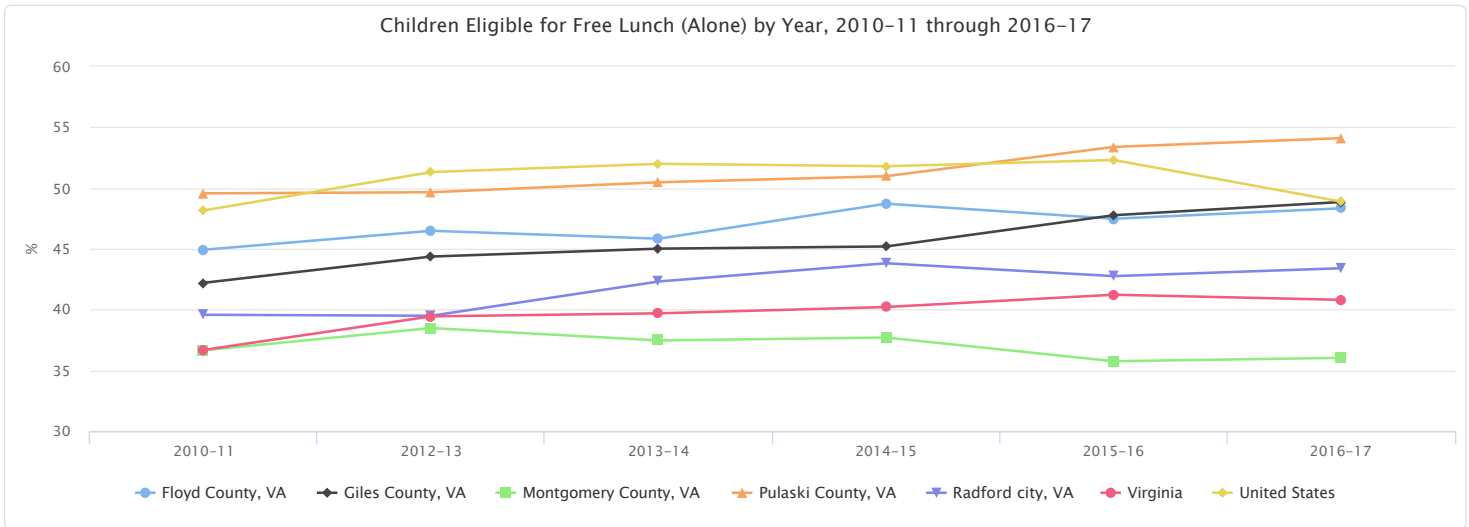

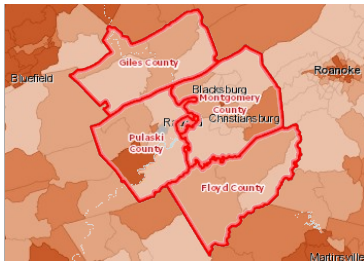


Households Receiving SNAP by Poverty Status (ACS)

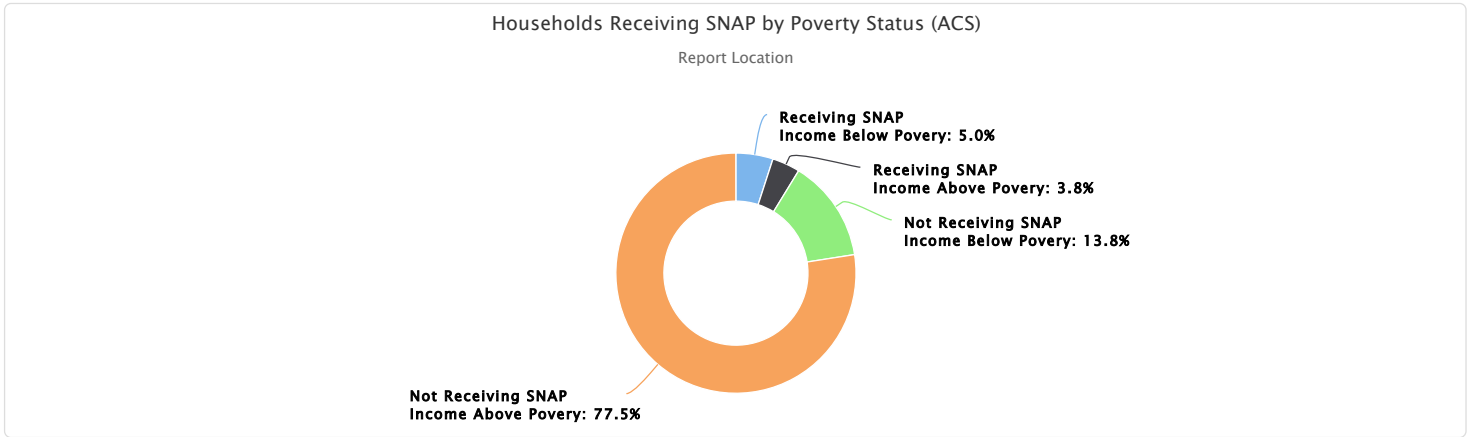
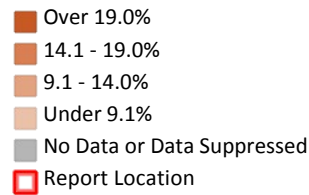

Households Receiving SNAP Benefits, Percent by Tract, ACS 2013-17



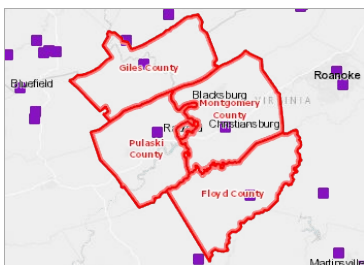

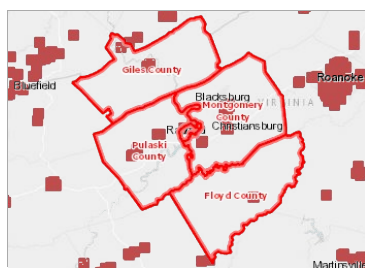

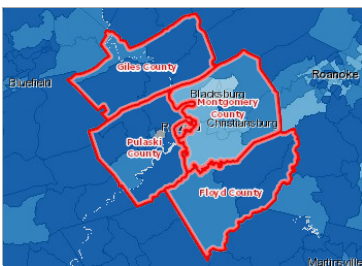

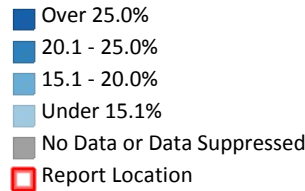

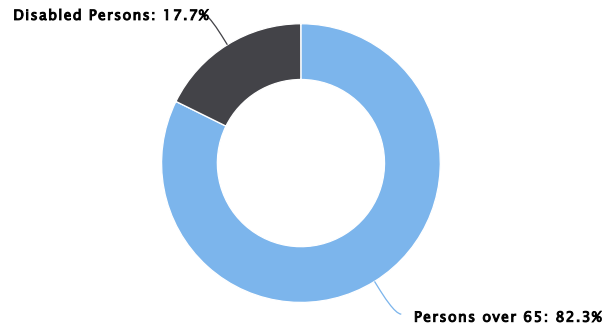
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Insured, Medicare, Percent by Tract, ACS 2013-17

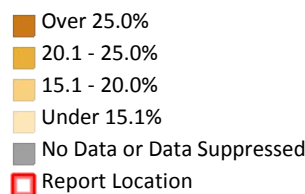

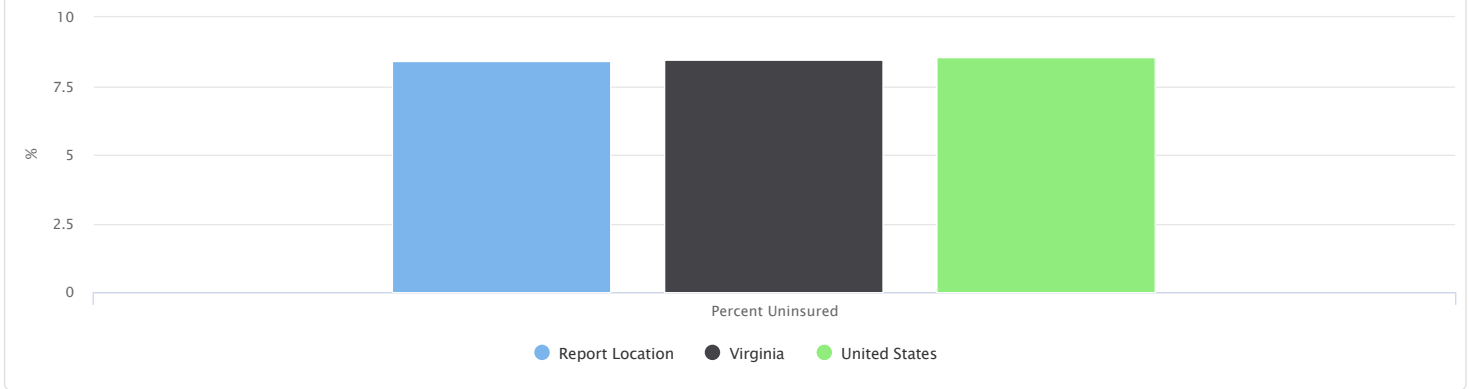


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Uninsured Population, Percent by County, SAHIE 2017
