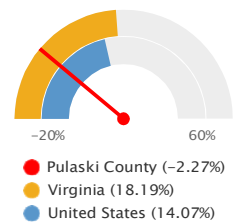

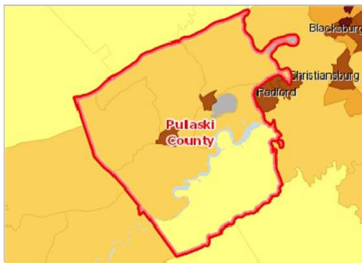

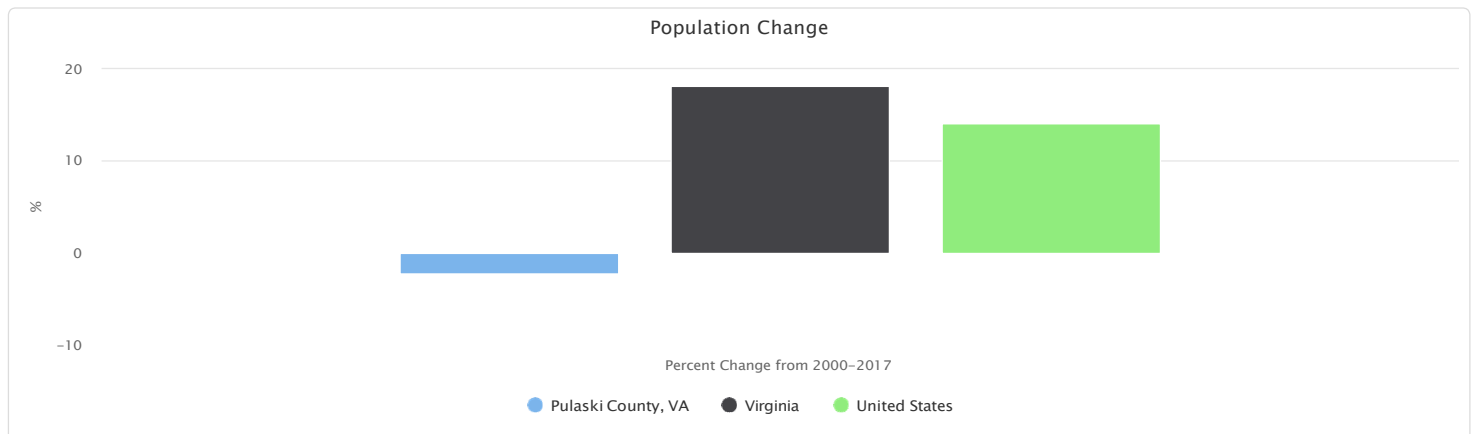

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Population, Density (Persons per Sq Mile) by Tract, ACS 2013-17

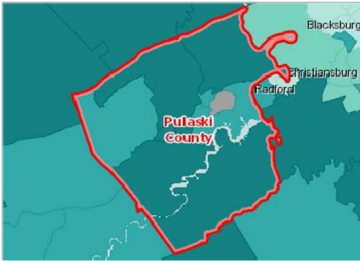

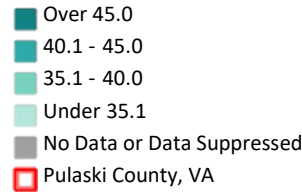

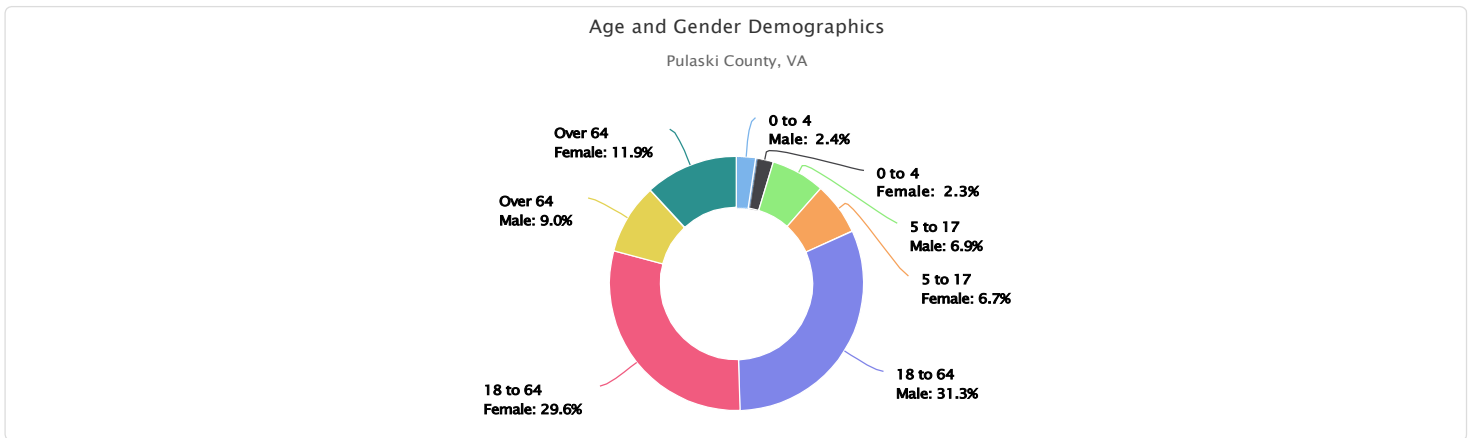

Median Age by Tract, ACS 2013-17



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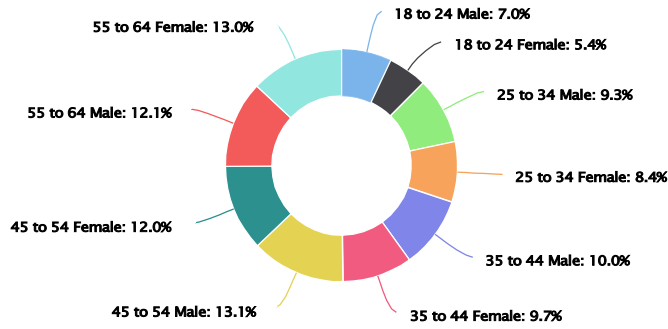

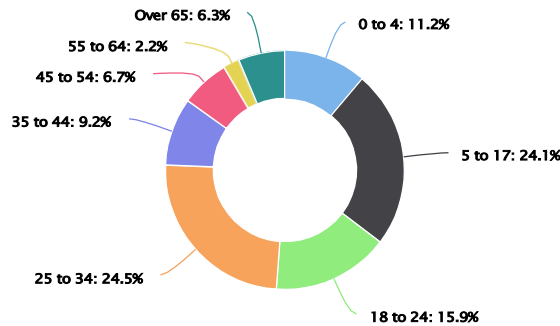

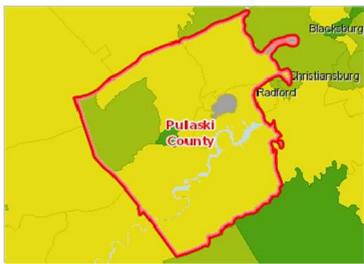


Race Demographics

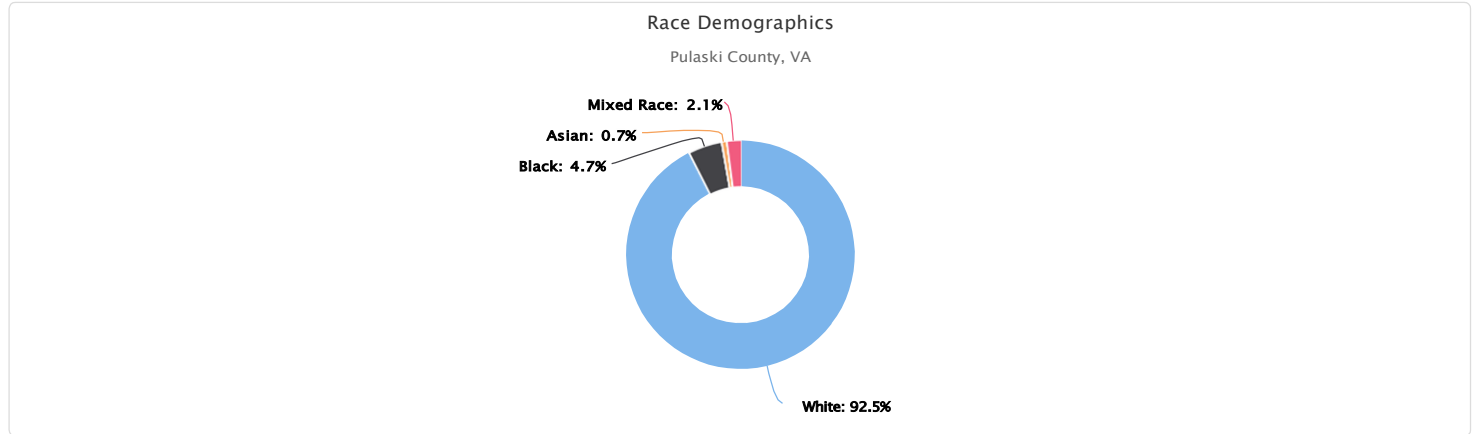
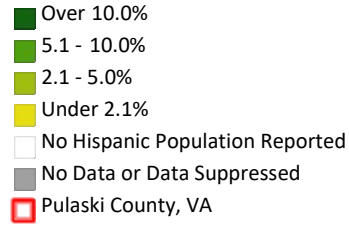

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Population, Minority (Non-White), Percent by Tract, ACS 2013-17

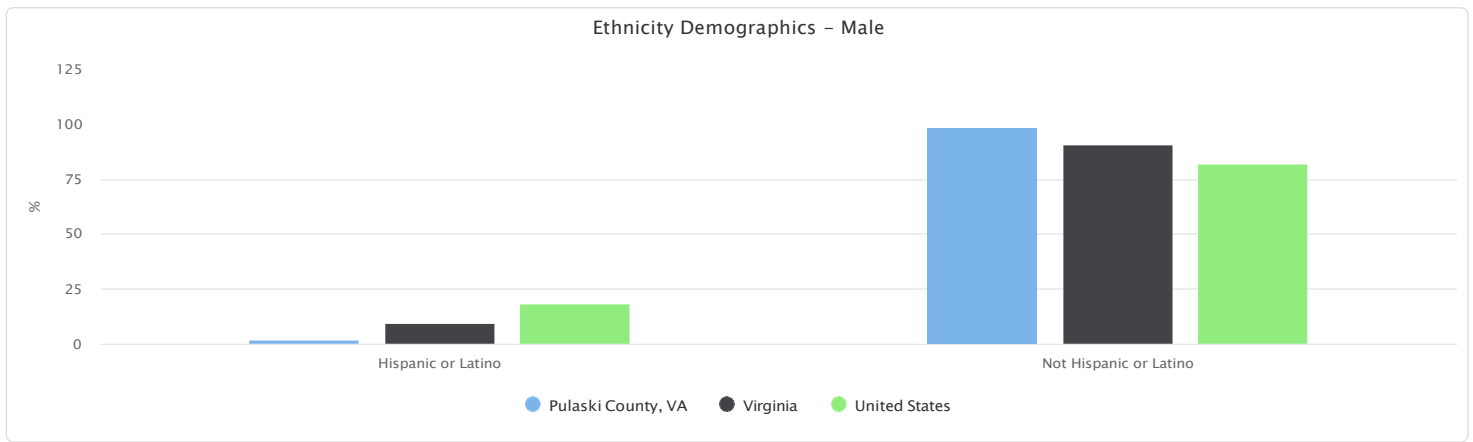

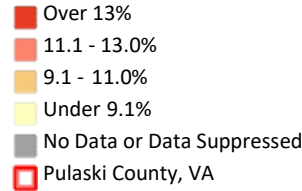

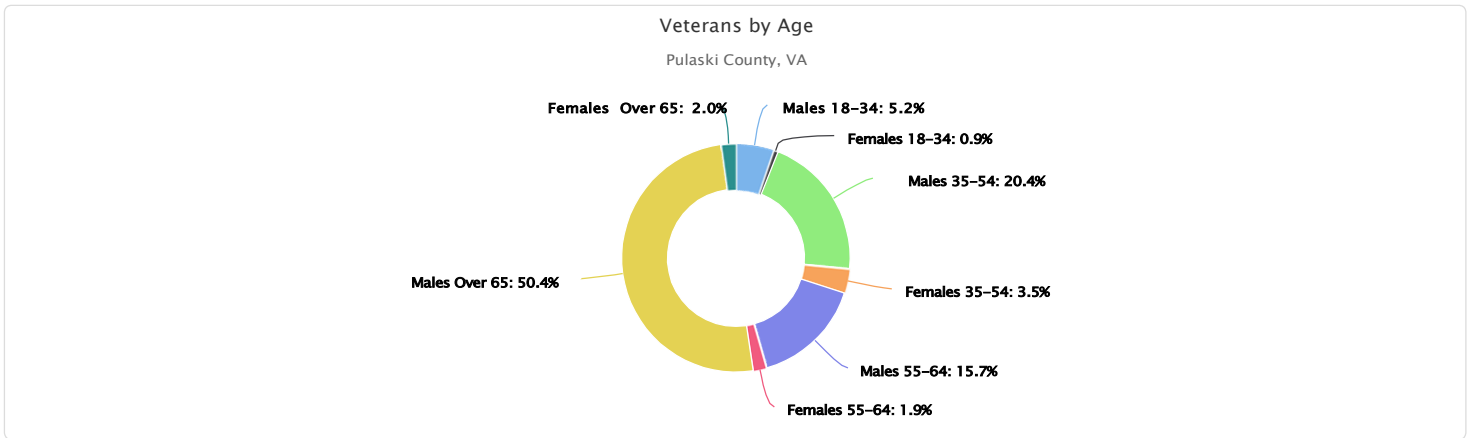
Veterans, Percent of Total Population by Tract, ACS 2013-17

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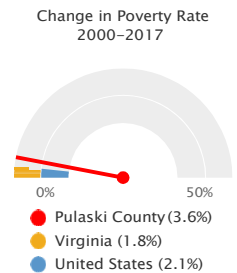
Population Below the Poverty Level, Percent by County, SAIGE 2017



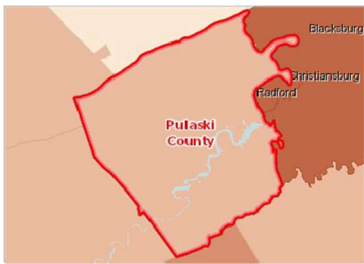
Poverty Rate Change

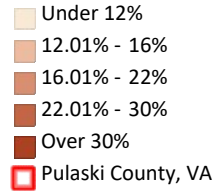

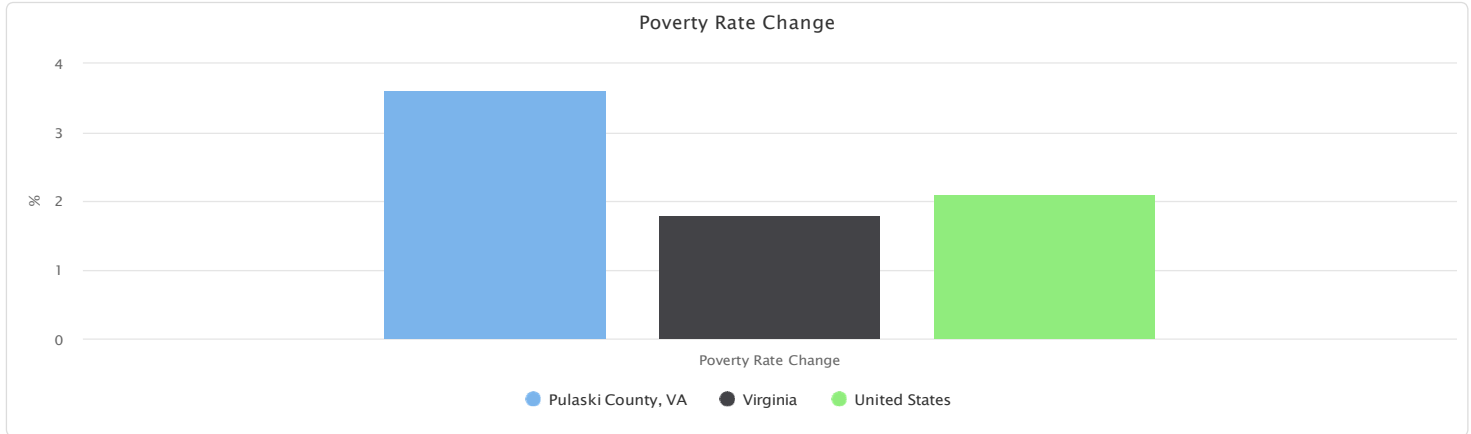

Population Below the Poverty Level, Percent by County, SAIPE 2017



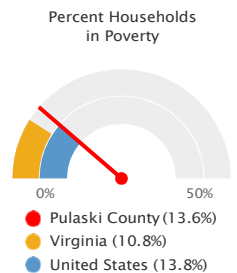
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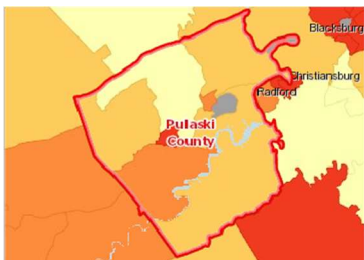

Households Living Below the Poverty Level, Percent by Tract, ACS 2013-17



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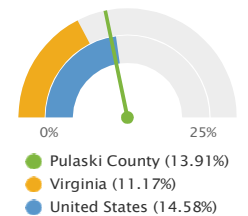
Poverty Rate (ACS)

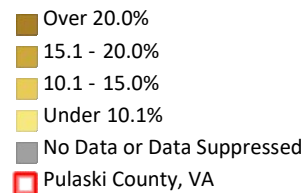

Percent Population in Poverty



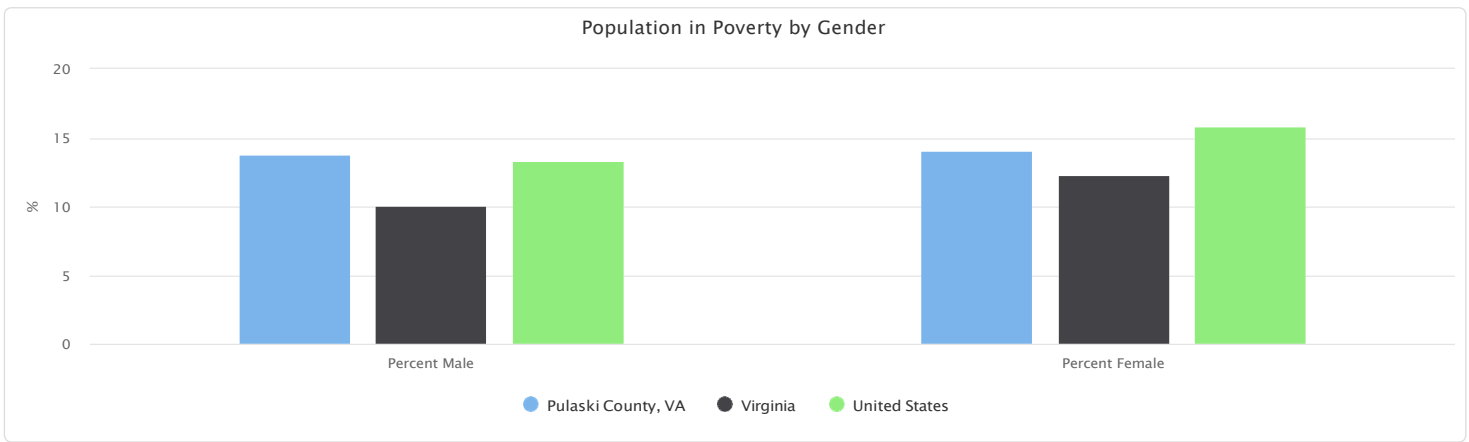
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Population Below the Poverty Level, Percent by Tract, ACS 2013-17



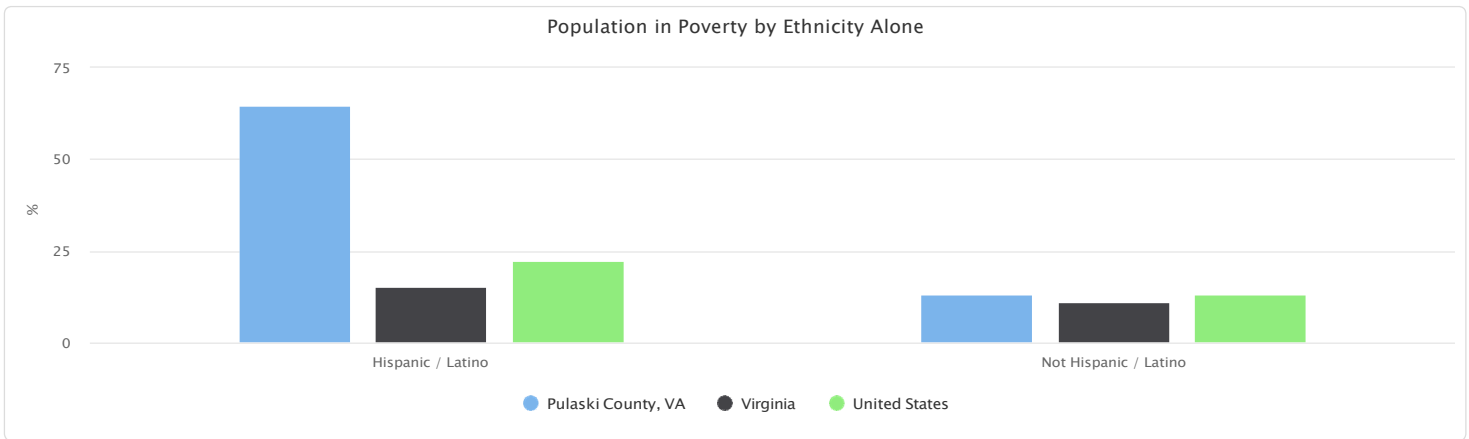

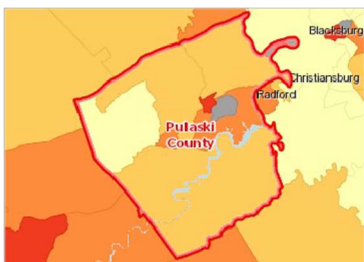

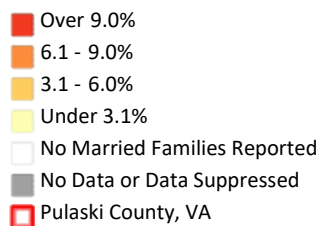

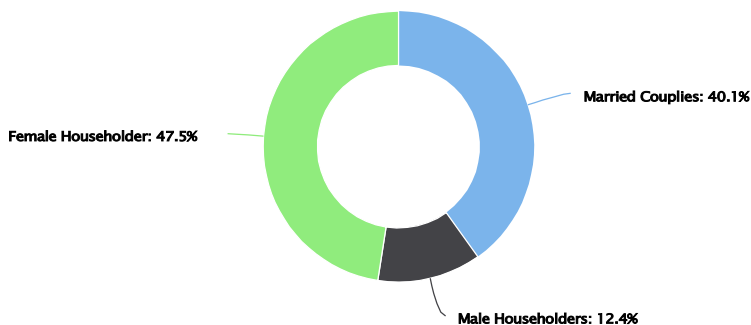
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Married Family Households Living Below the Poverty Level, Percent by Tract, ACS 2013-17

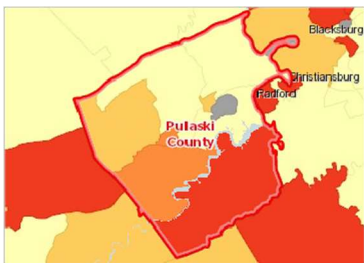
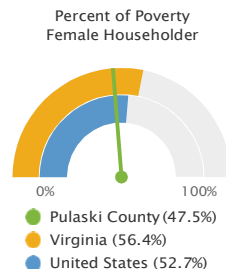


Family Poverty Rate by Family Type

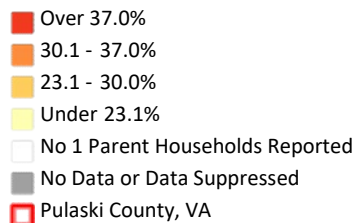

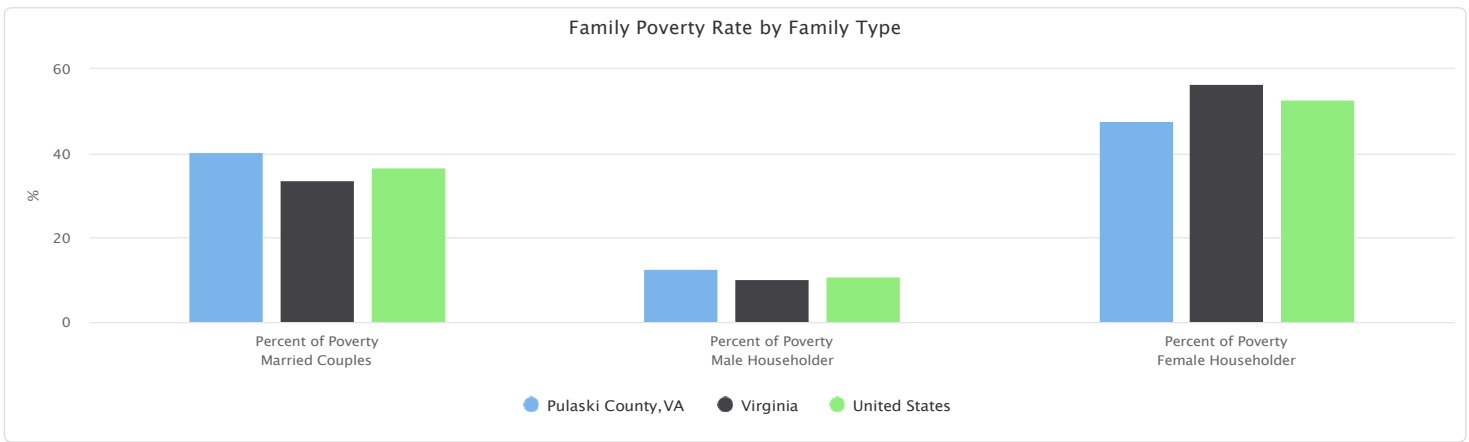

Single Parent Family Households Living Below the Poverty Level, Percent by Tract, ACS 2013-17



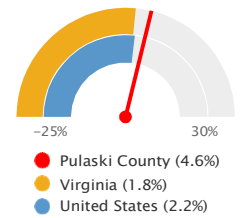

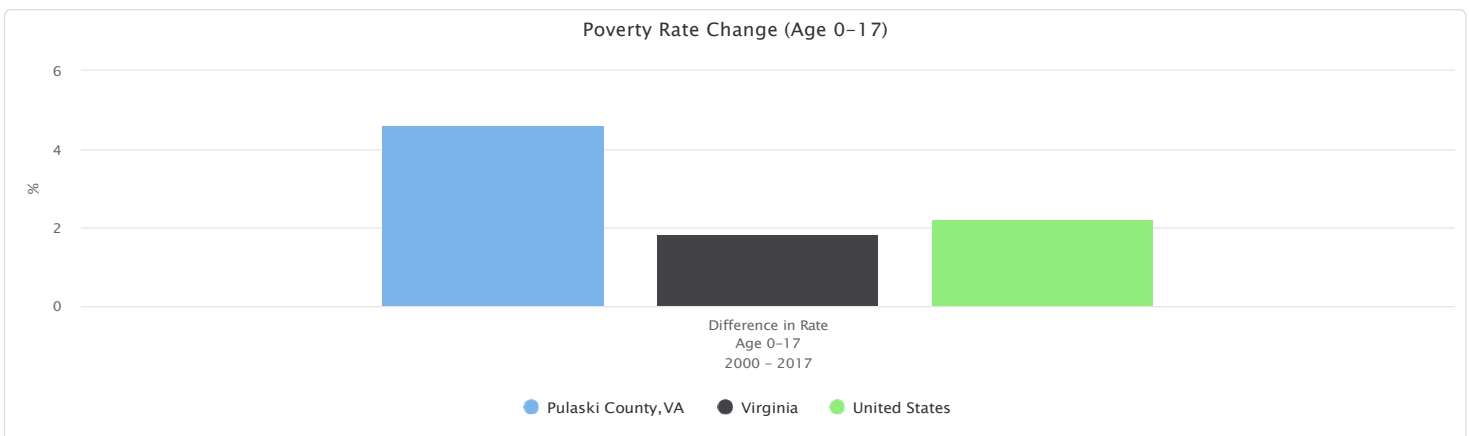
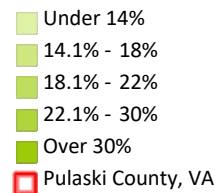

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Population Below the Poverty Level, Children (Age 0-18), Percent by County, SAIPE 2017

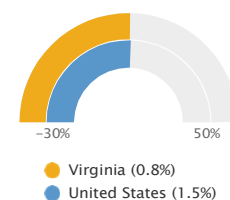


Poverty Rate Change (Age 0-4)

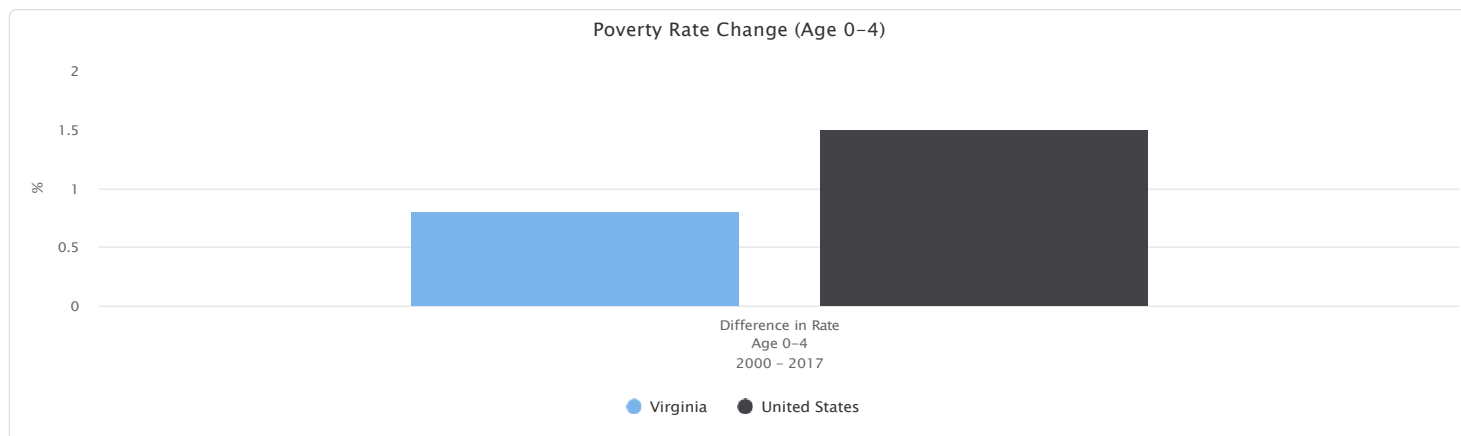
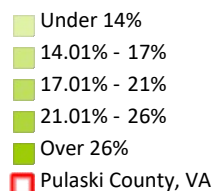

Population Below the Poverty Level, Children (Age 0-4), Percent by State, SAIPE 2017

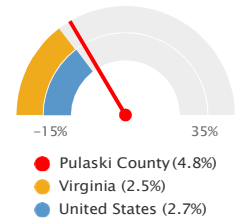

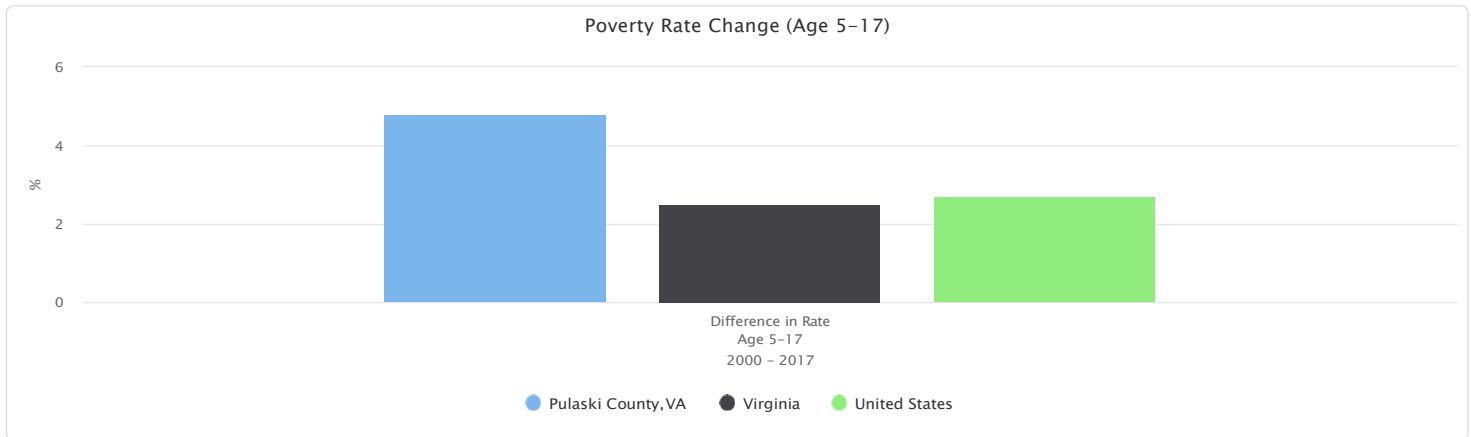
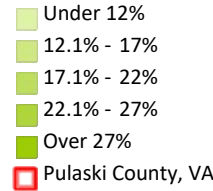

Population Below the Poverty Level, Children (Age 5-17), Percent by County, SAIPE 2017

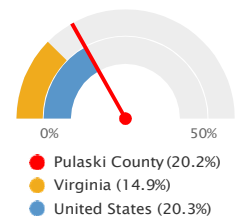

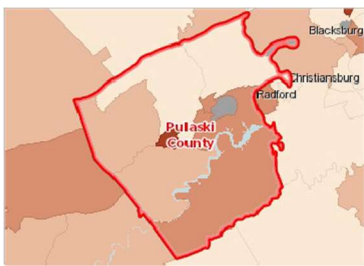

Population Below the Poverty Level, Children (Age 0-17), Percent by Tract, ACS 2013-17



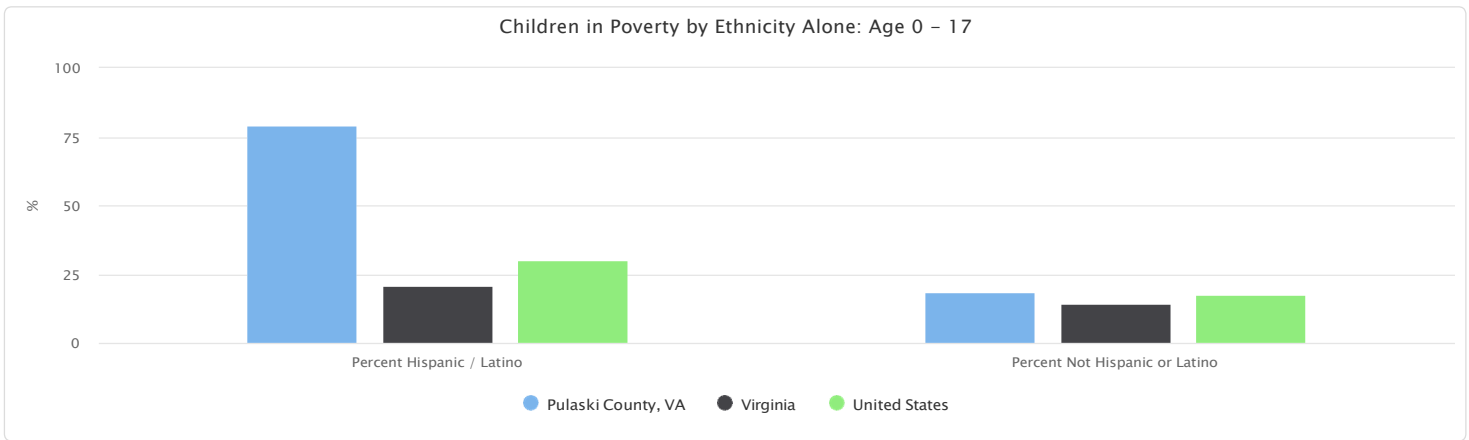

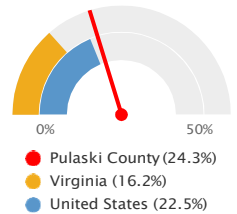

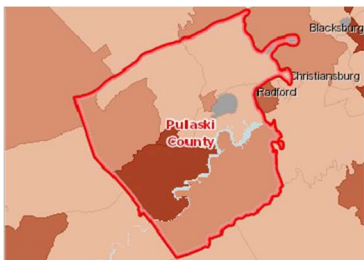

Child Poverty Rate (ACS) Ages 0-4



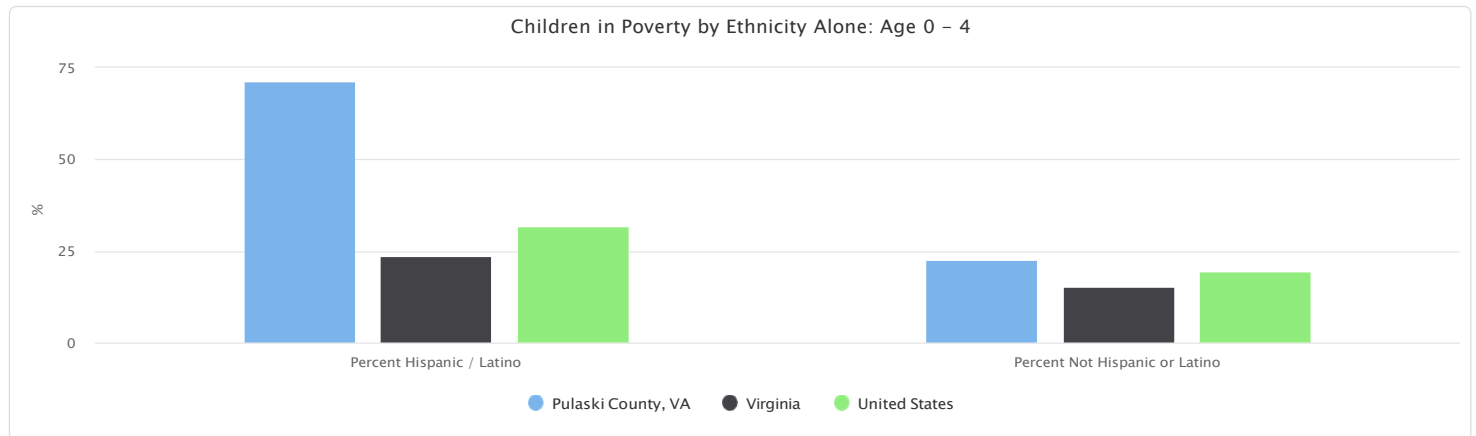

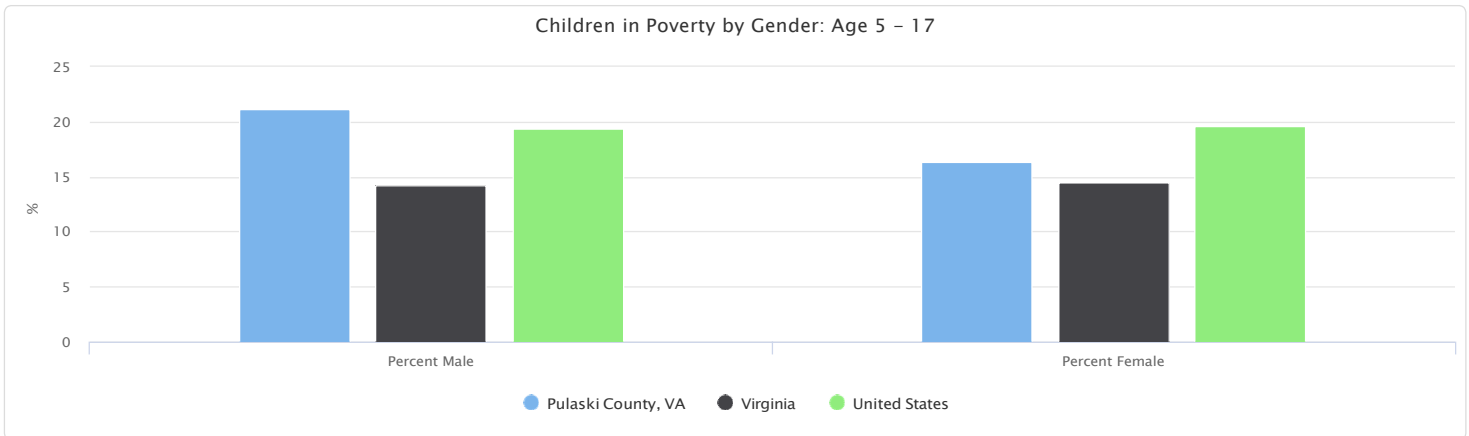
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Population Below the Poverty Level, Children (Age 5-17), Percent by Tract, ACS 2013-17



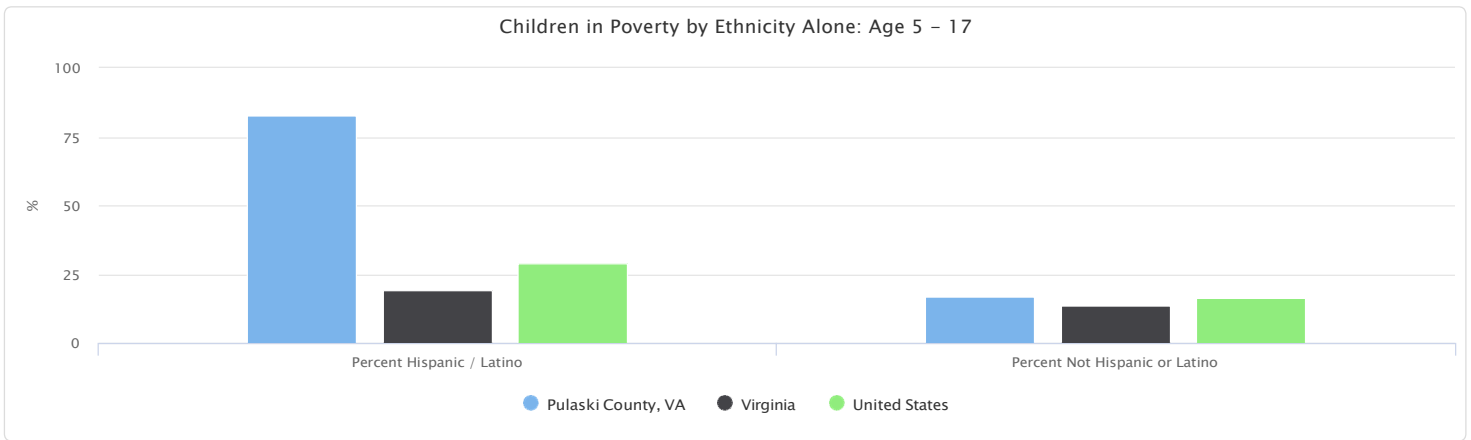

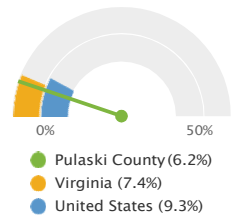

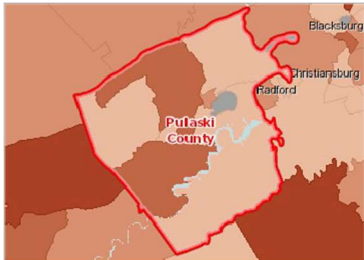

Ages 65 and Up Poverty Rate

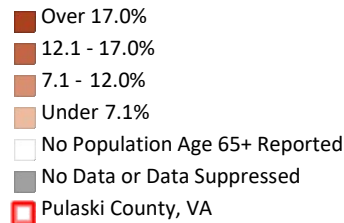

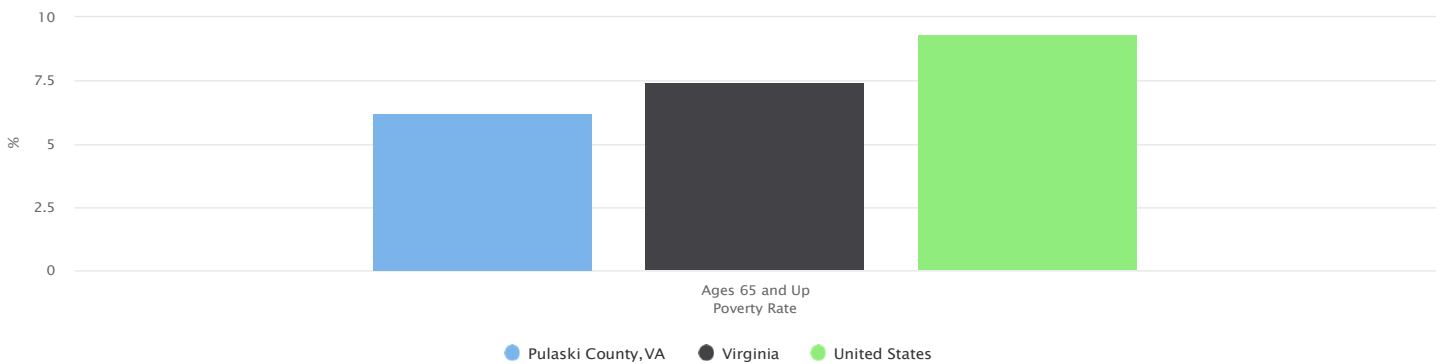


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Population Below the Poverty Level, Senior (Age 65+), Percent by Tract, ACS 2013-17

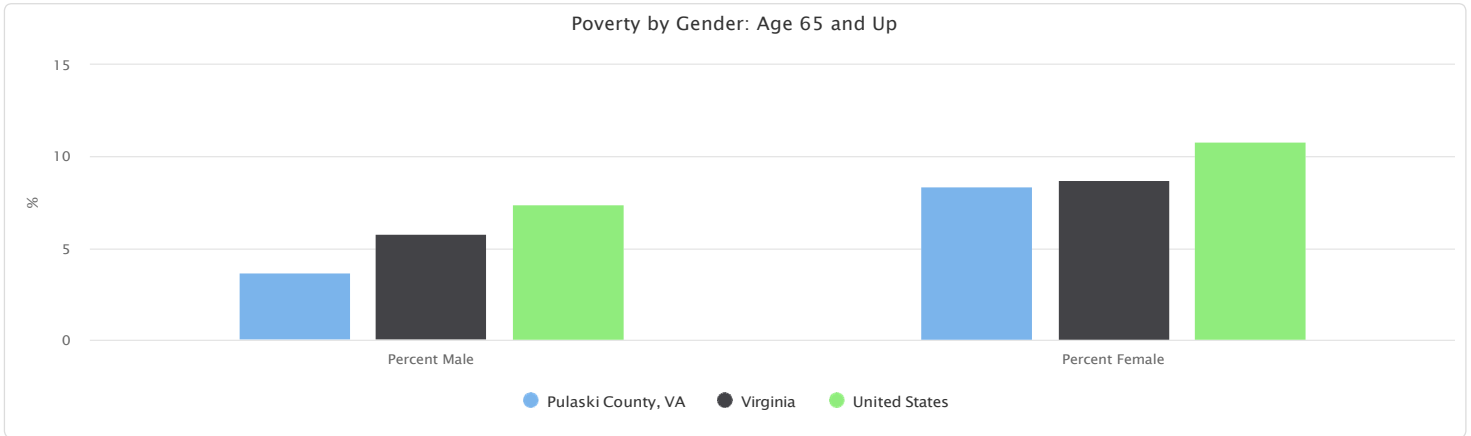

Unemployment, Rate by County, BLS 2019 - November

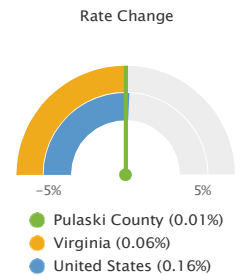

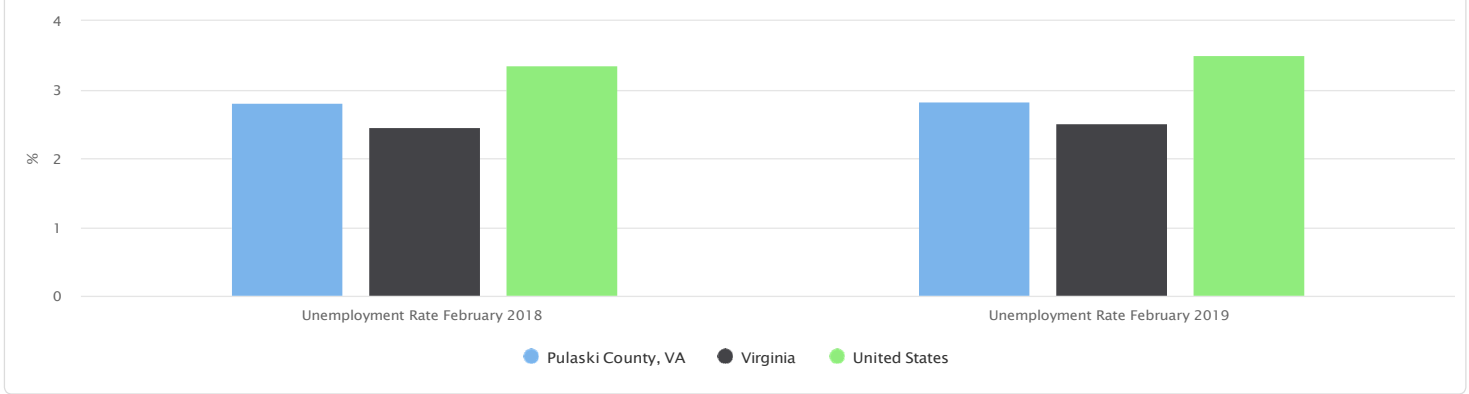

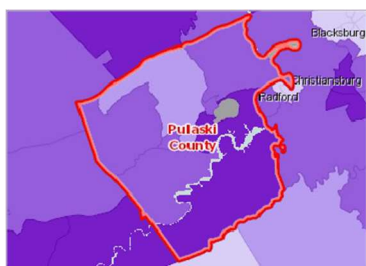

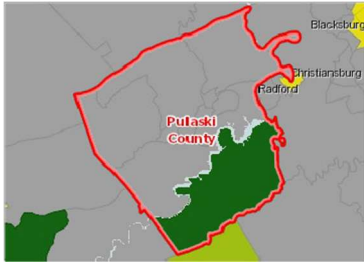

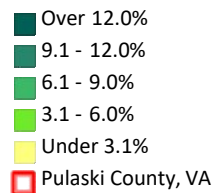

Population with No High School Diploma (Age 18+), Percent by Tract, ACS 2013-17



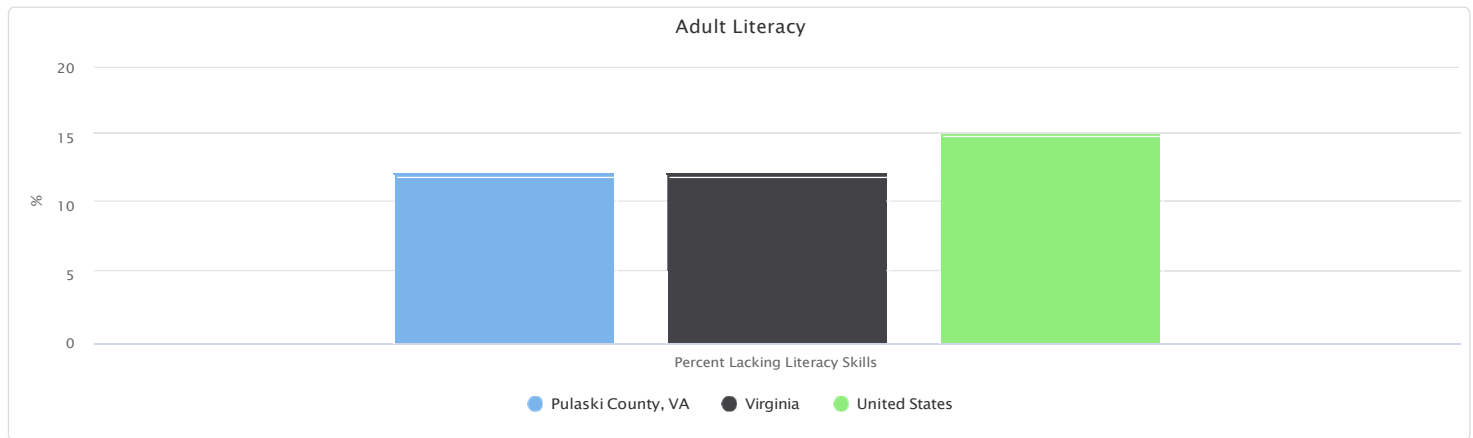
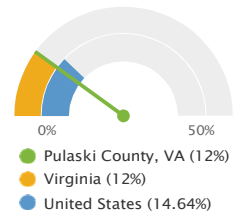

Percentage of Adults Lacking Literacy Skills

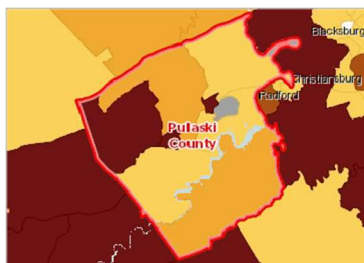

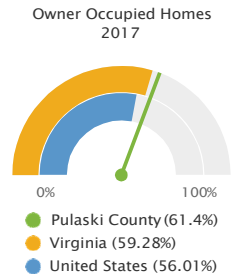
Housing Constructed Before 1960, Percent by Tract, ACS 2013-17



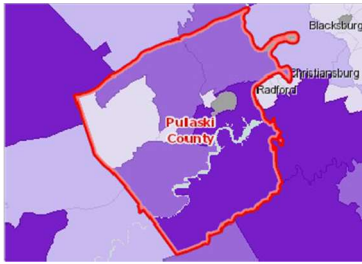

Residential Vacancies, Percent by Tract, HUD 2019-Q2



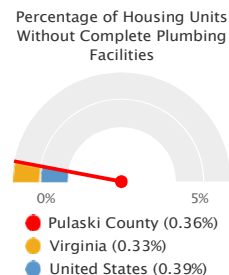

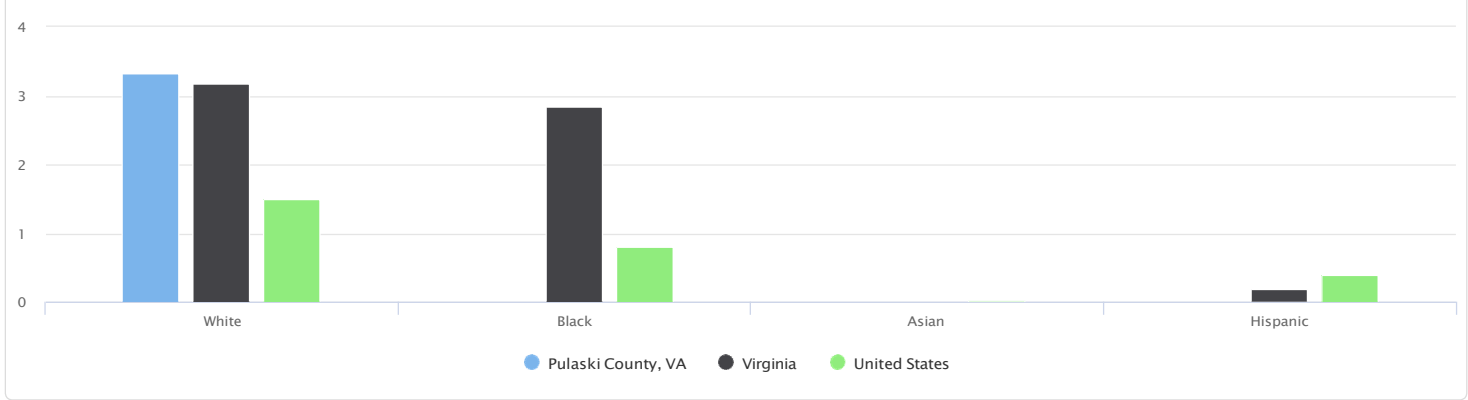


Eviction Filings and Filing Rate by Neighborhood Predominant Race/Ethnicity, 2016

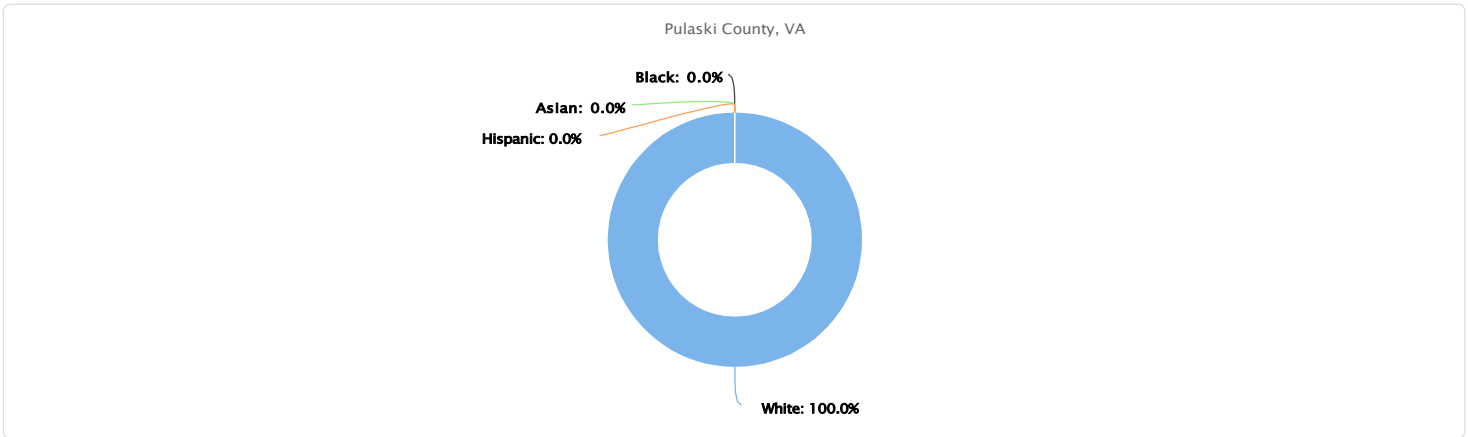

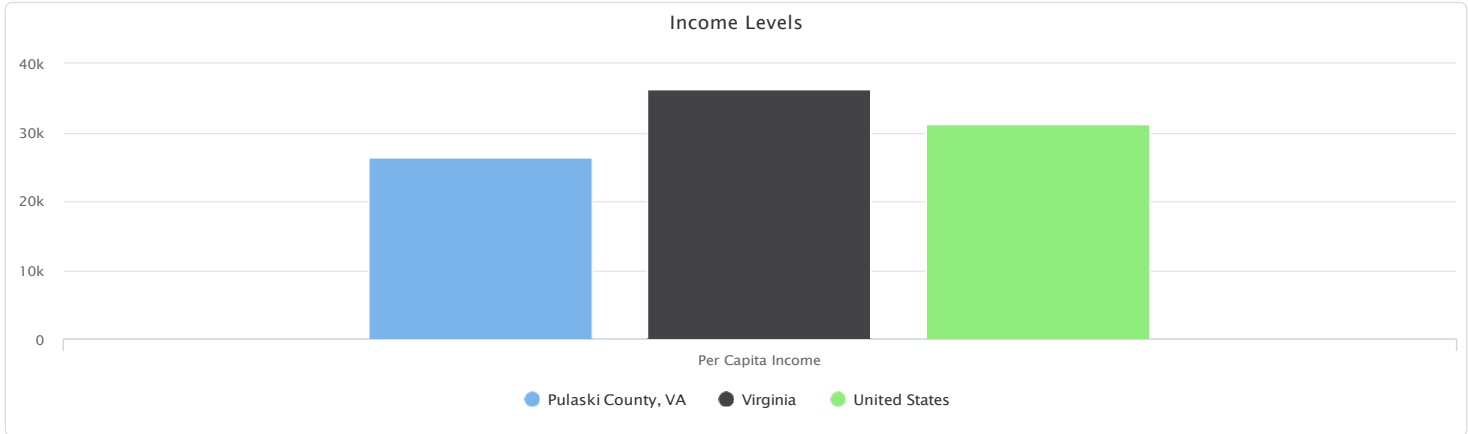

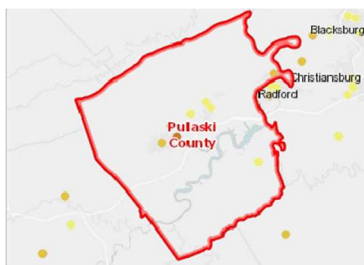

Percent Students Eligible for Free or Reduced Price Lunch



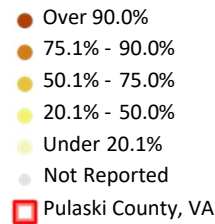

Students Eligible for Free or Reduced-Price Lunch, NCES CCD 2016-17

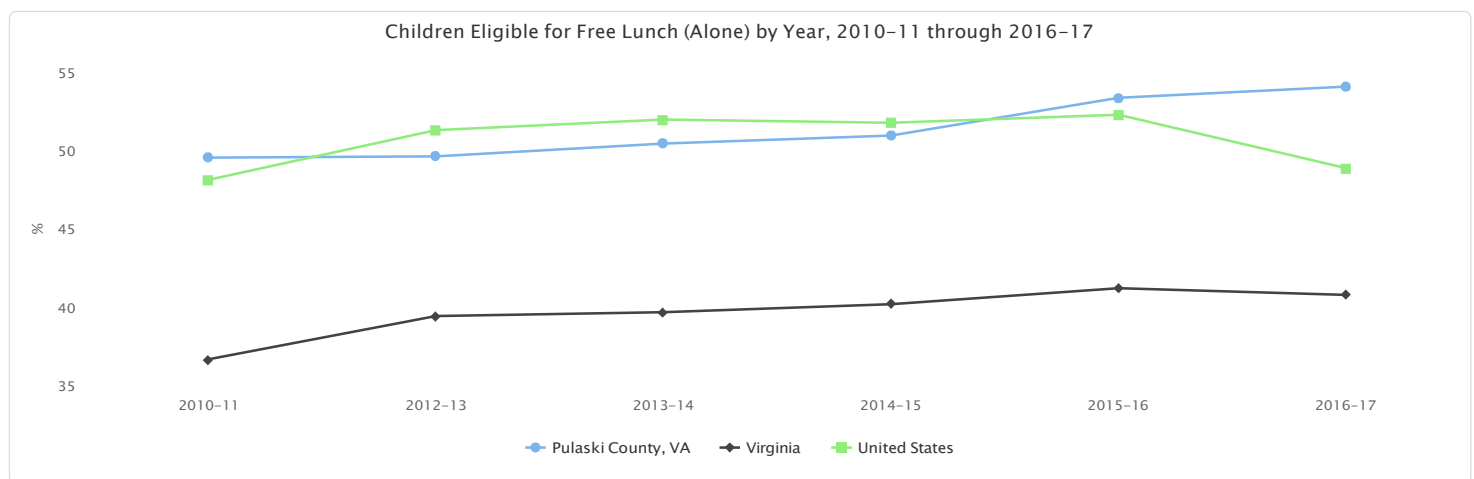


Children Eligible for Free Lunch (Alone) by Year, 2010-11 through 2016-17

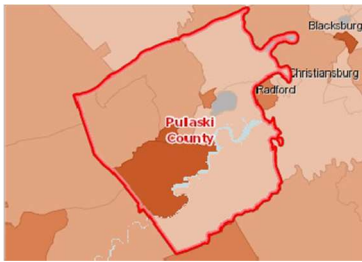

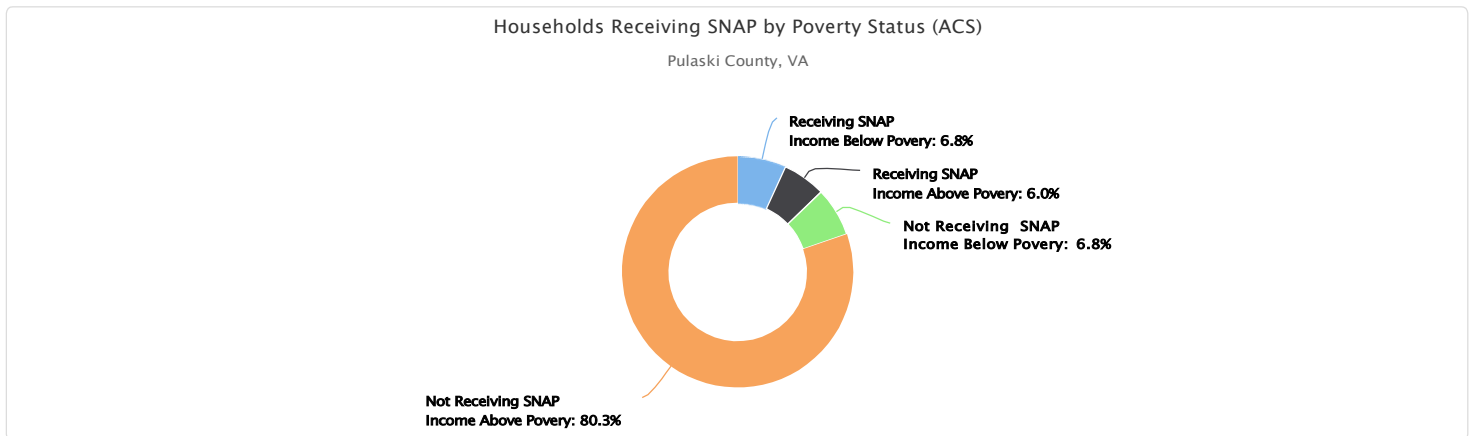
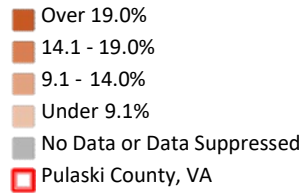

Households Receiving SNAP Benefits, Percent by Tract, ACS 2013-17



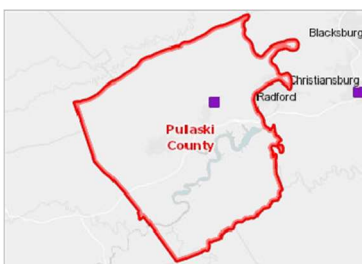
