The Education Specialists will share the program's child assessment outcomes next month. Parents will receive the TSG outcomes for individual children from their classroom teachers on joint home visits with Family/Health Advocates.

- The annual Parent Survey will go out to parents during our next home visit cycle starting February 6th.

- I am working on the annual staff survey. The target date it is available to staff is April 1st.
- Last month I attended the National Head Start Winter Leadership Institute in Washington D.C. Along with the

 regarding the updates to the masking and full enrollment mandates, the progress on Head Start's COLA increase
