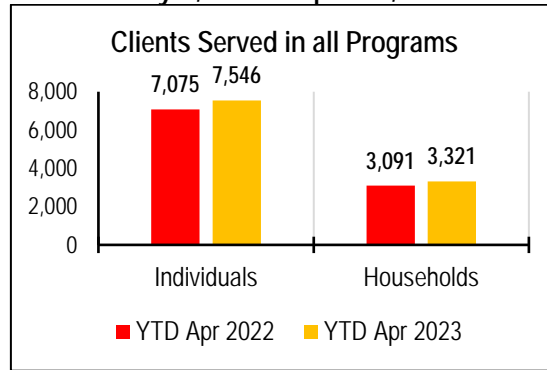

NUTRITION	HOUSING	WHOLE FAMILY APPROACH
<p><b>EMERGENCY FOOD</b> was distributed to <b>1,809</b> individuals in <b>881</b> families.</p> <p><b>FLOYD BACKPACK</b> provided <b>4,495</b> food bags to <b>155</b> students in <b>96</b> families.</p>	<p><b>RAPID REHOUSING</b> assisted <b>120</b> families to obtain shelter.</p> <p><b>HOMELESS PREVENTION</b> assisted <b>57</b> families to obtain or maintain shelter.</p> <p><b>HOUSING COUNSELING</b> provided <b>51</b> families with knowledge to improve their housing and financial situations.</p> <p><b>GROUP EDUCATION</b> workshops were provided to <b>53</b> individuals covering rental and financial literacy topics.</p> <p><b>TO OUR HOUSE</b> (season extended to Apr 10) sheltered <b>55</b> individuals, providing a total of <b>1,830</b> bed-nights and <b>4,918</b> meals.</p> <p><b>HOUSING SERVICES LINE</b> completed <b>153</b> intakes for housing services.</p> <p><b>AFTER-HOURS HOMELESS LINE</b> answered <b>104</b> calls for after-hours homeless assistance.</p>	<p><b>HEAD START</b> provided comprehensive education, nutrition, health, parent engagement and social services to <b>347</b> pre-school children.</p> <p><b>CHIP</b> provided <b>203</b> children aged 0-6 in <b>139</b> families with improved health care, parent education and case management.</p> <p><b>WHOLE FAMILY</b> engaged <b>12</b> families (<b>7</b> Giles, <b>5</b> Pulaski) in wrap-around support and case management.</p>
