
NRCA BOARD REPORT

NUTRITION

EMERGENCY FOOD was distributed to **1,583** individuals in **761** families.

FLOYD BACKPACK provided **3,192** food bags to **152** students in **94** families.

FINANCIAL

EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE served **3,876** individuals in **1,570** families addressing basic needs including rent payments and deposits, utility bills and deposits, transportation, and clothing.

VOLUNTEER INCOME TAX
ASSISTANCE (VITA) completed 382
returns.

HOUSING

RAPID REHOUSING assisted **114** families to obtain shelter.

HOMELESS PREVENTION assisted **54** families to obtain or maintain shelter.

HOUSING COUNSELING provided **52** families with knowledge to improve their housing and financial situations.

GROUP EDUCATION workshops were provided to **46** individuals covering rental and financial literacy topics.

TO OUR HOUSE sheltered 47 individuals, providing a total of 1,253 bed-nights and 3,759 meals.

HOUSING SERVICES LINE completed **104** intakes for housing services.

AFTER-HOURS HOMELESS LINE answered 98 calls for after-hours homeless assistance.

WHOLE FAMILY APPROACH

HEAD START provided comprehensive education, nutrition, health, parent engagement and social services to 344 pre-school children.

CHIP provided **188** children aged 0-6 in **128** families with improved health care, parent education and case management.

WHOLE FAMILY engaged **10** families (**6** Giles, **4** Pulaski) in wrap-around supports and case management.

TRANSITION

VA CARES supported 17 pre-release and 48 newly released ex-offenders to successfully transition from prison to the community.
