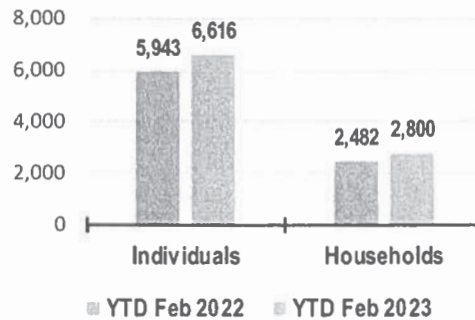

NUTRITION	HOUSING	WHOLE FAMILY APPROACH
<p>EMERGENCY FOOD was distributed to 1,583 individuals in 761 families.</p> <p>FLOYD BACKPACK provided 3,192 food bags to 152 students in 94 families.</p>	<p>RAPID REHOUSING assisted 114 families to obtain shelter.</p> <p>HOMELESS PREVENTION assisted 54 families to obtain or maintain shelter.</p> <p>HOUSING COUNSELING provided 52 families with knowledge to improve their housing and financial situations.</p> <p>GROUP EDUCATION workshops were provided to 46 individuals covering rental and financial literacy topics.</p> <p>TO OUR HOUSE sheltered 47 individuals, providing a total of 1,253 bed-nights and 3,759 meals.</p> <p>HOUSING SERVICES LINE completed 104 intakes for housing services.</p> <p>AFTER-HOURS HOMELESS LINE answered 98 calls for after-hours homeless assistance.</p>	<p>HEAD START provided comprehensive education, nutrition, health, parent engagement and social services to 344 pre-school children.</p> <p>CHIP provided 188 children aged 0-6 in 128 families with improved health care, parent education and case management.</p> <p>WHOLE FAMILY engaged 10 families (6 Giles, 4 Pulaski) in wrap-around supports and case management.</p>
